



41-Foot Crest Protection Plan – {Fargo}

- Plan for 2-feet of freeboard
 - ▶ Top of emergency measures at 43-feet
- ► Existing Infrastructure
 - ► Earth Levee Approx. 21.7 miles
 - ➤ Concrete Floodwall Approx. 2.4 miles
 - ▶ Removable Floodwall 12 locations
 - ▶ Storm Sewer Lift Stations 75
- Emergency Measures
 - **Earth Levee** Approx. 9.0 miles
 - ▶ Trap Bags Approx. 3.7 miles
 - ► Sandbags Approx. 5.3 miles
 - ► Gravel Blisters Approx. 0.3 miles
 - ▶ **Secondary Levee** Approx. 0.6 miles







Interactive Flood Stage Map - {Fargo}






Sandbag Operations – {Cass County}

- ► Sandbag Cass: Goal 300,000 sandbags
 - What: Volunteer to build sandbags
 - ▶ Where: Cass County Highway Department, 1201 Main Avenue West, West Fargo.
 - ▶ When: Mon-Fri: 9am-8pm, Sat 8am-7pm, and Sun 12pm-7pm

► Empty Sandbags:

- ▶ Sold in bundles of 1,000 for \$100 at the Cass County Highway Department,
- ► Cass County deliver a load of sand for every bundle of sandbags.

Filled Sandbags: Prioritize delivering filled sandbags

- ▶ Homes impacted by our levee construction will get 2000-3000.
- ▶ Homes in rural subdivisions that volunteer at Sandbag Cass will try to deliver 1000 bags per home (based on sandbag availability).
- ► Available for emergency delivery.
