SUBJECT: Liquor Control Committee Meeting

The Liquor Control Committee will be meeting on Wednesday December 21, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. in the City Commission Room at City Hall.

Agenda items are:

1. Approve minutes of the October 19, 2016 meeting.

2. Review Liquor Applications
 - a. Application to issue a Class F alcoholic beverage license to Izumi Sushi and Hibachi All You Can Eat, Inc. d/b/a Izumi Sushi and Hibachi Buffet to be located at 5050 13th Avenue South.
 - b. Application to transfer a Class ABH alcoholic beverage license from BDH Hotel Ventures LLC d/b/a Radisson Hotel Fargo to 201 Hospitality LLP d/b/a Radisson Hotel Fargo to be located at 201North 5th Street.
 - c. Application to issue a Class FA-RZ alcoholic beverage license to Vinyl Taco, Inc. d/b/a Vinyl Taco to be located at 520 1st Avenue North. The owners are requesting the Class AB license currently at Vinyl Taco be transferred to JL Beers South Inc. d/b/a JL Beers located at 4240 32nd Avenue South, the owners are requesting the Class M designation remain at JL Beers to allow the sale of growlers.
 - d. Application to issue a class FA-RZ alcoholic beverage license to JL Beers, Inc. d/b/a JL Beers to be located at 518 1st Avenue North. The owners are requesting to keep the Class M designation to allow the sale of growlers at this location. In addition, the owners are requesting the transfer of the existing Class D to BFG, Inc. d/b/a Borrowed Bucks Roadhouse which currently has a Class A license. The Class D license would allow the sale of beer off sale. Finally, the owners are willing to relinquish the Class C licenses to the City.

3. Review Class FA-RZ changes as previously instructed. Remove gaming and Class E restrictions and discontinue issuance of this class license. February 24, 2016 minutes attached.
