WHEREAS, It is important to value and recognize multisector collaboration.

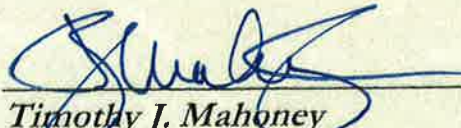
