Sign Application Requirements

It is the applicant's responsibility to provide the information listed and any other documentation necessary so that the application and plans can be reviewed in a timely manner. If you fail to provide sufficient documentation there may be delays to your project.

Site Plan Requirements for Free-Standing Signs:

- a) north arrow and scale;
- b) street names;
- c) property lines;
- d) property dimensions;
- e) sight triangles;
- f) existing and proposed buildings and other structures;
- g) parking areas, drives, and curb cuts on the lot;
- h) drive aisles and/or vehicle circulation areas;
- i) location of existing sign(s);
- j) placement of proposed sign(s); and
- k) sign location in relationship to property lines or curbs (dimensions).

Plan Requirements:

- a) the type of each proposed sign(s);
- b) the area of all existing signs;
- c) the area of proposed sign face(s);
- d) the zoning of the property and the allowable signage for that property or tenant;
- e) sign dimensions, including height, width and depth of supporting structure(s);
- f) sign face design;
- g) an elevation drawing of all proposed signs, to include dimensions and height above street grade for each face;
- h) illumination specifications, if any;
- i) engineered drawing and schedules if required;
- i) a photographic simulation; and
- k) if this is an off-premises sign and located along a state highway, North Dakota State Department of Transportation approval.

Plans for signs attached to a building must show:

- a) where you plan to have the sign attached to the building;
- b) the dimensions of the front wall of the building or lease space;
- c) the dimensions of the sign(s); and
- d) a completed Existing Sign Survey showing the dimensions of any existing signs on the property or lease space as well as any pylon or other sign that may advertise that lease space.

Notes

- It is illegal to install a sign without a permit except as allowed under the City of Fargo Sign Code.
- You must also get a wiring certificate via a licensed electrician if your sign will use electricity.
- All illuminated signs must meet the requirements of the City of Fargo Sign Code.
