



## Report References

The following report is using data that has been extracted from the Fargo Police Department Law Enforcement Records Management System.

### Number of Calls for Service

Calls for Service per Beat is a count of all criminal and non-criminal calls for service.

- Calls for Service may be community generated or officer-initiated calls.
- Calls for Service include reports completed by citizens using the online reporting system (DORS).
- Calls for Service may be handled by Officers in the field or over the phone.
- Calls for Service do not always result in a police case report being taken, and may not involve any criminal offenses/charges.

### Case Offenses

Case Offenses per Beat is a count of case reports in which a NIBRS defined Group A Offense was reported.

- Group A Offenses are defined by the FBI's National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS), and does *not* include all possible criminal offense categories.
- Cases with multiple Group A Offenses reported are counted in *each* of the offense categories.
- The offense category "All Rape" includes Forcible Rape, Forcible Sodomy, and Sexual Assault with an Object. (Statutory Rape and Forcible Fondling are their own category)
- Case offenses may be added, removed, or be re-categorized if or when the case information changes throughout the course of an investigation. Thus, you may see both current and historic numbers change over time.
  - For example, when a victim is shot but not killed, the offense is categorized as an Aggravated Assault. If the victim later dies, the offense is then re-categorized as a Murder/Non-Negligent Manslaughter. Another example is if a citizen reports their vehicle as stolen, the offense is categorized as a Motor Vehicle Theft. If the citizen later discovers their vehicle had actually been towed and was *not* stolen, the case becomes 'unfounded' and therefor the Motor Vehicle Theft offense is no longer counted.

### Shootings & Shots Fired Cases (data manually tracked by Fargo PD Intelligence & Analysis Unit)

Shootings per Beat is a count of cases where a victim sustains injuries due to the use of a firearm, but is not killed.

- The offense in these cases are categorized as an Aggravated Assault.
- If a shooting victim is killed, the case is NOT counted as a Shooting, and the offense is categorized as a Murder/Non-Negligent Manslaughter.

Shots Fired per Beat is a count of cases where gun shots were both reported AND confirmed by evidence such as, locating ammunition casings and/or damage to property or structures due to a firearm.

- Shots Fired cases do NOT result in any reported injuries.



## August Crime Data – Analysts Notes:

### Citywide

- Calls for Service were **↓5%** from July to August. Calls for Service are **↑6%** compared to the previous year, however, is due to the increase in traffic stops, which now accounts for 16% of all CFS in 2025 to date.
- Offenses were **↓8%** in August, as well as **↓13%** compared to the previous year.
  - Notably, Offenses were down from July to August, as well as compared to the previous year in all Beats except Beat 4, which had only a slight 4% increase in both August and compared to the previous year.
- Shootings are **↓80%** compared to the previous year, and Shots Fired are also **↓25%** in 2025.
- Aggravated Assaults were **↑52%** from July to August, largely due to an increase in Beat 2. Aggravated Assaults however are still **↓29%** compared to the previous year. 47% of Aggravated Assaults in 2025 to date are domestic violence related.
- Burglary was **↓8%** from July to August and is **↓37%** compared to the previous year. Notably, burglary was also down in all Beats in August. Kenneth Blackwell was identified as a suspect in four burglaries in August, and Jason Koonce in two.
  - 87% - Residential Burglaries
    - 62% of residential burglaries were to the garages
      - 61% occurred at apartment complexes
      - 39% occurred at single family homes
  - 11% - Commercial Burglaries
    - 50% of commercial burglaries occurred at storage units/rental facilities
  - 2% - Industrial/Construction Site Burglaries
- Counterfeiting/Forgery was **↓32%** from July to August, however is up **↑31%** compared to the previous year.
  - In 2025, eight individuals have been identified as repeat offenders, three of which have accounted for at least four cases each.
- Forcible Fondling **↑175%** (by 7 cases) from July to August, due to an increase in Beat 3 by five cases in August. No commonalities or pattern identified. Forcible Fondling however is still **↓11%** compared to the previous year.
- Motor Vehicle Theft was **↑16%** from July to August due to an increase in thefts in Beats 2 and 4. Motor Vehicle Theft however is still **↓7%** compared to the previous year.
  - 40% of vehicles were unlocked, 37% had keys left inside the vehicle, and 12% were running when stolen in August
  - Approx. 60.5% of stolen vehicles in August have been recovered
    - 77% recovered in Fargo
    - 19% recovered in Moorhead, MN
    - 4% recovered in West Fargo
  - Mary Ozuna and David Jacobsen each identified as suspects in two MV theft cases in August
- Theft from Motor Vehicles was **↑26%** from July to August, due to an increase in thefts in Beats 1 and 2. Theft from Motor Vehicles however is still **↓50%** compared to the previous year. Theft of Motor Vehicle Parts/Accessories was also **↑150%** in August due to an increase in thefts in Beat 5, and is also **↑4%** compared to the previous year.
- Shoplifting was **↓12%** from July to August, however, is still **↑27%** compared to the previous year due to significant increases in shoplifting cases in Beats 1 and 4. (See Beats for additional details)
  - 3 repeat shoplifters identified in August
  - Brandon Gunhammer identified as a suspect/person of interest in five separate cases in August, and in approx. 11 cases in 2025



## August Crime Data – Analysts Notes:

### Beat 1

- Shootings are **↓one case** compared to the previous year, and Shots Fired are **↑one case** in 2025.
- Theft from Motor Vehicles was **↑200%** (by 6 cases) from July to August, however, is still **↓50%** compared to the previous year.
  - No common suspects identified
  - All occurring to vehicles parked on the street in residential areas during overnight hours
  - 33% had forced entry/damage to the vehicle
- Shoplifting was **↓28%** from July to August, however, is **↑304%** compared to the previous year.
  - In 2025, 81 of the 93 shoplifting cases (87%) were reported from the following two locations:
    - Family Fare: 54 cases
      - **↑23%** (by 10 cases) in August
      - **↑1,250%** from the previous year (from 4 cases to 54)
    - Hornacher's Northport: 27 cases
      - **↑1 case** in August
      - **↑145%** from the previous year (from 11 cases to 27)

### Beat 2

- Shootings are **↑2 cases** compared to the previous year, and Shots Fired are **↑300%** (by 3 cases) in 2025.
- Aggravated Assaults were **↑225%** (by 9 cases) from July to August, however, are still **↓29%** compared to the previous year.
  - Only 12% of Aggravated Assaults were domestic violence related
  - Most cases occurred in the downtown Broadway area on Saturday's between the hours of 00:00-01:00 in August
  - Eight arrests made, one pending SA, and two pending investigations
- MV Theft was **↑100%** from July to August, and is also **↑28%** compared to the previous year.
  - All occurred on residential street parking or parking lots
  - 60% of vehicles were recovered locally
  - Mary Ozuna arrested in two cases
- Theft from MV was **↑175%** from July to August, however, is still **↓54%** compared to the previous year.
  - Downtown area accounted for 15% of the August Vehicle Break-Ins (4 at Roberts Commons ramp, 2 at Mercantile ramp, 1 at the US Bank parking lot, and 1 at a parking lot near Roberts St N.) Most thefts in these cases involved known homeless individuals.
  - Mary Ozuna arrested in one case and the suspect in one case



## August Crime Data – Analysts Notes:

### Beat 3

- Shootings are **↓100%** (by 2 cases) compared to the previous year, and Shots Fired are **↓67%** in 2025.
- Shoplifting was **↓10%** from July to August, however, is still **↑11%** compared to the previous year.
  - In 2025, 132 of the 153 shoplifting cases (86%) were reported from the following three locations:
    - Cash Wise: 68 cases
      - **↑4** cases in August
      - **↓9%** from the previous year
    - Cash Wise Liquor: 34 cases
      - **↑48%** (by 11 cases) in August
    - Hornbacher's Express: 30 cases
      - **↑3** cases in August
      - **↑650%** from the previous year (from 4 cases to 30)

### Beat 4

- Shootings remained unchanged compared to the previous year, and Shots Fired are **↓50%** in 2025.
- Offenses are slightly **↑4%** from July to August, and are also **↑4%** compared to the previous year. This increase in 2025 is due to a significant increase in Drug Equip/Narcotics Violations as well a significant increase in Shoplifting cases (see details below).
- Motor Vehicle Theft was **↑250%** (by 5 cases) from July to August, however, is **↓2%** compared to the previous year.
  - Most vehicles stolen from apartment parking lots while unlocked
  - 50% of the stolen vehicles have been recovered in August
- Burglary was **↓20%** from July to August, however, is **↑15%** compared to the previous year.
  - 95% - Residential Burglaries
    - 71% occurring at apartment complexes
      - 60% to apartment garages
      - 40% to the interior building or a unit
    - 29% occurring at single family homes
      - All to garages
  - 5% - Commercial Burglary (storage/rental facility)
- Shoplifting was **↓20%** from July to August, however, is still **↑109%** compared to the previous year.
  - In 2025, 102 of the 117 shoplifting cases (87%) were reported from the following three locations:
    - Family Fare: 40 cases
      - **↑6** cases in August
      - **↑1,900%** from the previous year (from 2 cases to 40)
    - Fleet Farm: 39 cases
      - **↑4** cases in August
      - **↑95%** from the previous year (from 20 cases to 39)
    - Hornbacher's: 23 cases

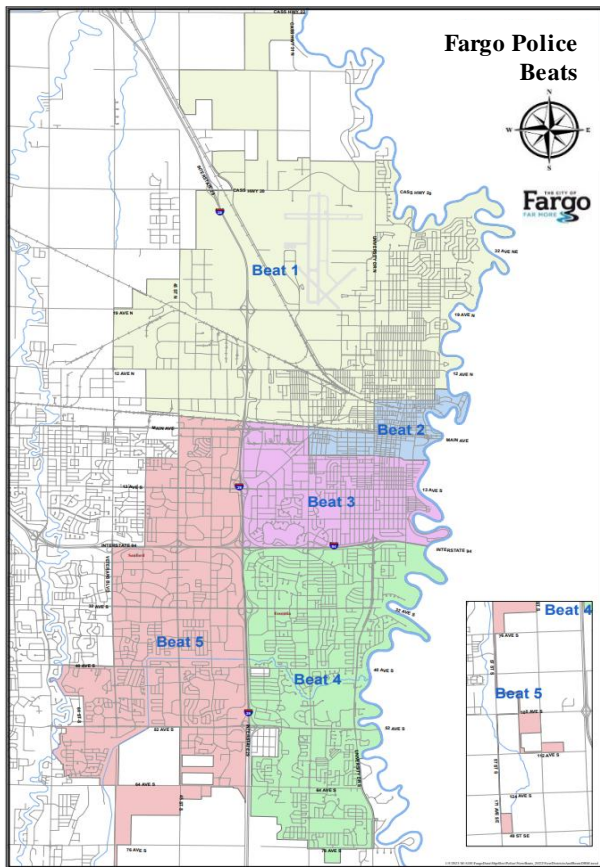
### Beat 5

- Shootings are **↓one case** compared to the previous year, and Shots Fired are also **↓50%** in 2025.
- Fraud-False Pretenses/Swindle was **↑250%** from July to August, as well as **↑45%** compared to the previous year.
  - An arrest was made or suspect identified in all cases in August
- Theft of MV parts/accessories was **↑5** cases from July to August, however, is still **↓27%** compared to the previous year.
  - Most cases in August were batteries or other parts stolen from vehicles in commercial parking lots overnight along Main Ave. Leroy Braun identified as a person of interest.
- Shoplifting was **↓9%** from July to August, however, is still up **↑12%** compared to the previous year.
  - In 2025, Beat 5 accounts for 57% of *all* reported shoplifting cases in Fargo. Notably, 408 of the 516 cases (79%) were reported from the following five locations:
    - Scheels: 165 cases
      - **↓36%** (by 10 cases) in August
      - **↑29%** from the previous year (from 128 cases to 165)
    - Walmart (4101 13<sup>th</sup> Ave S): 90 cases
    - West Acres: 82 cases
      - **↑64%** from the previous year (from 50 cases to 82)
    - Target: 37 cases
    - Village West Strip: 34 cases



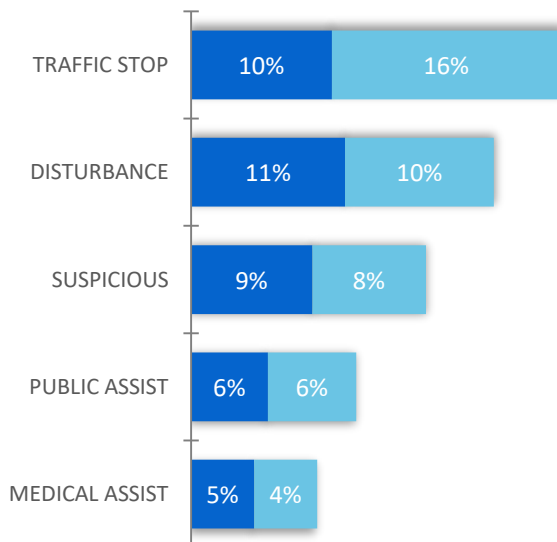

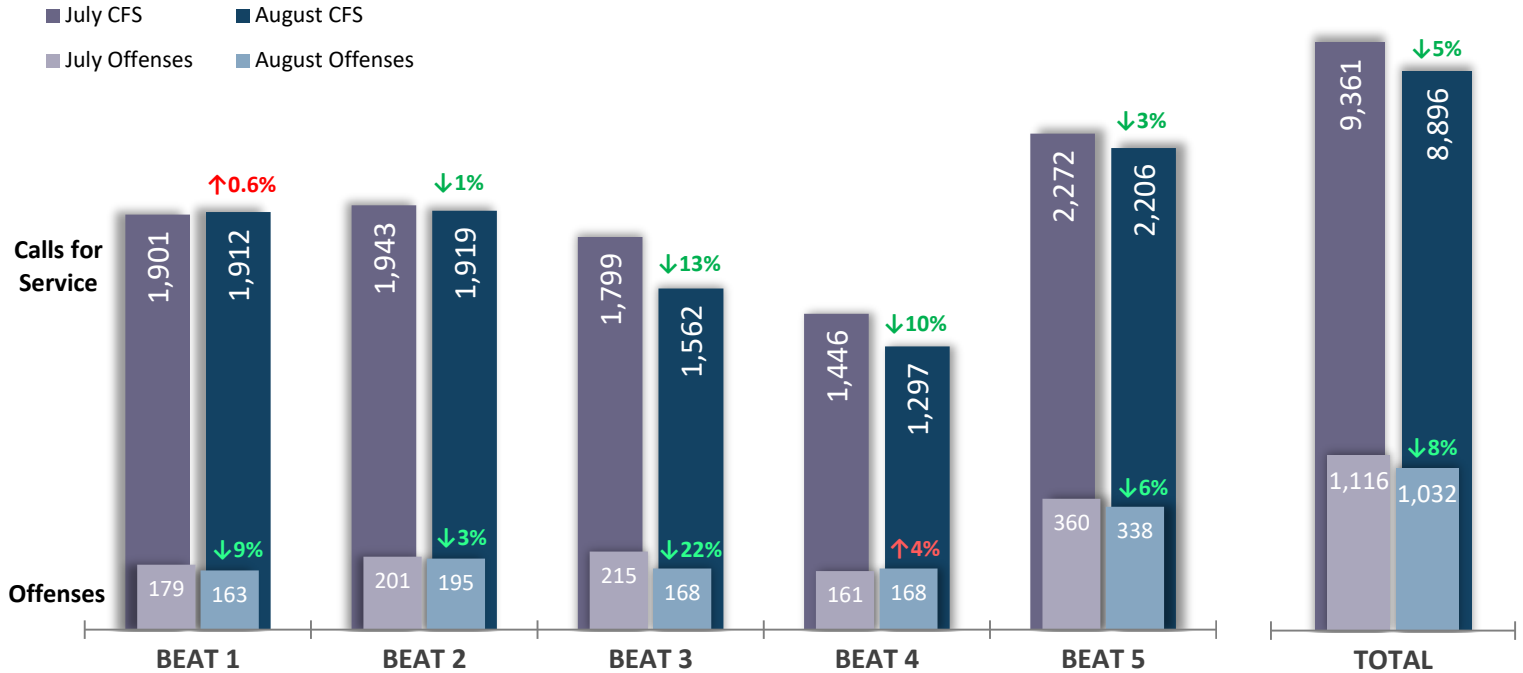




## NUMBER OF CFS BY BEAT

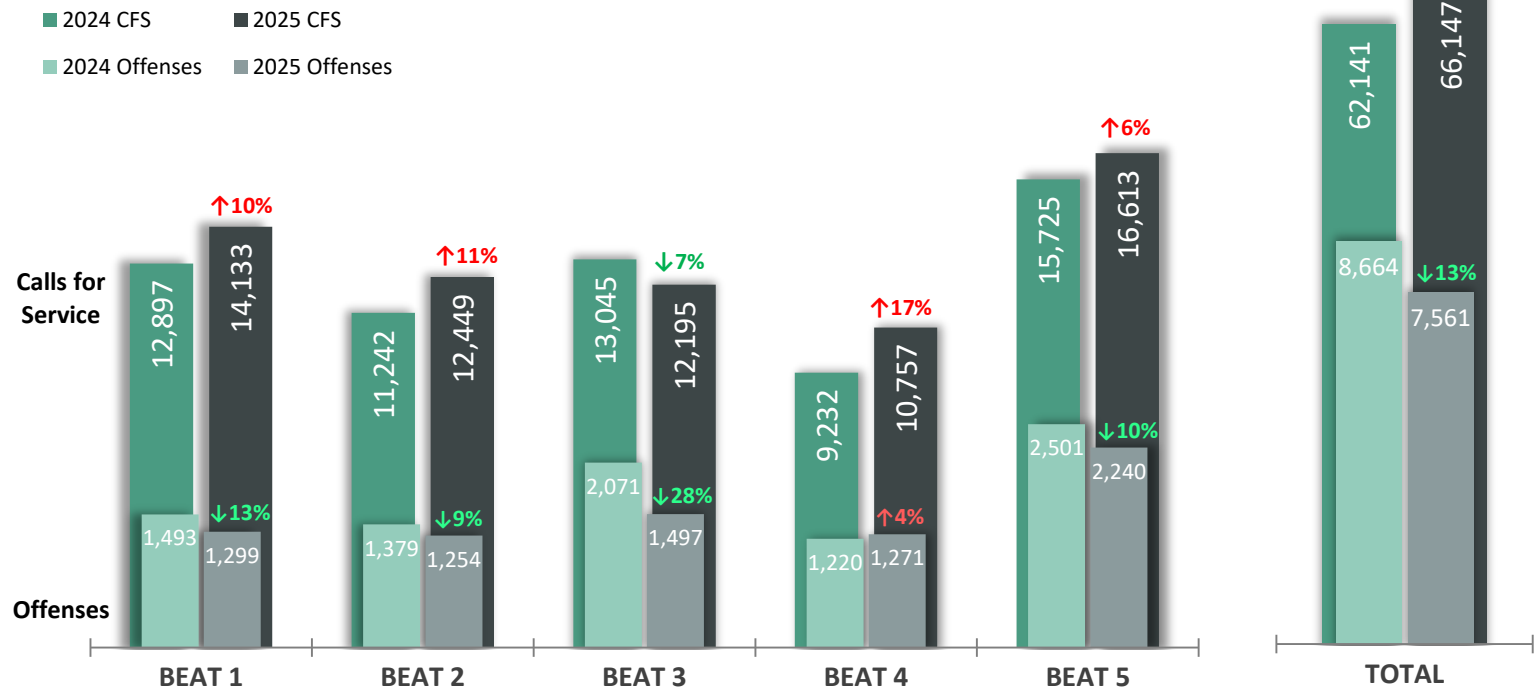
## NUMBER OF GROUP A OFFENSES BY BEAT

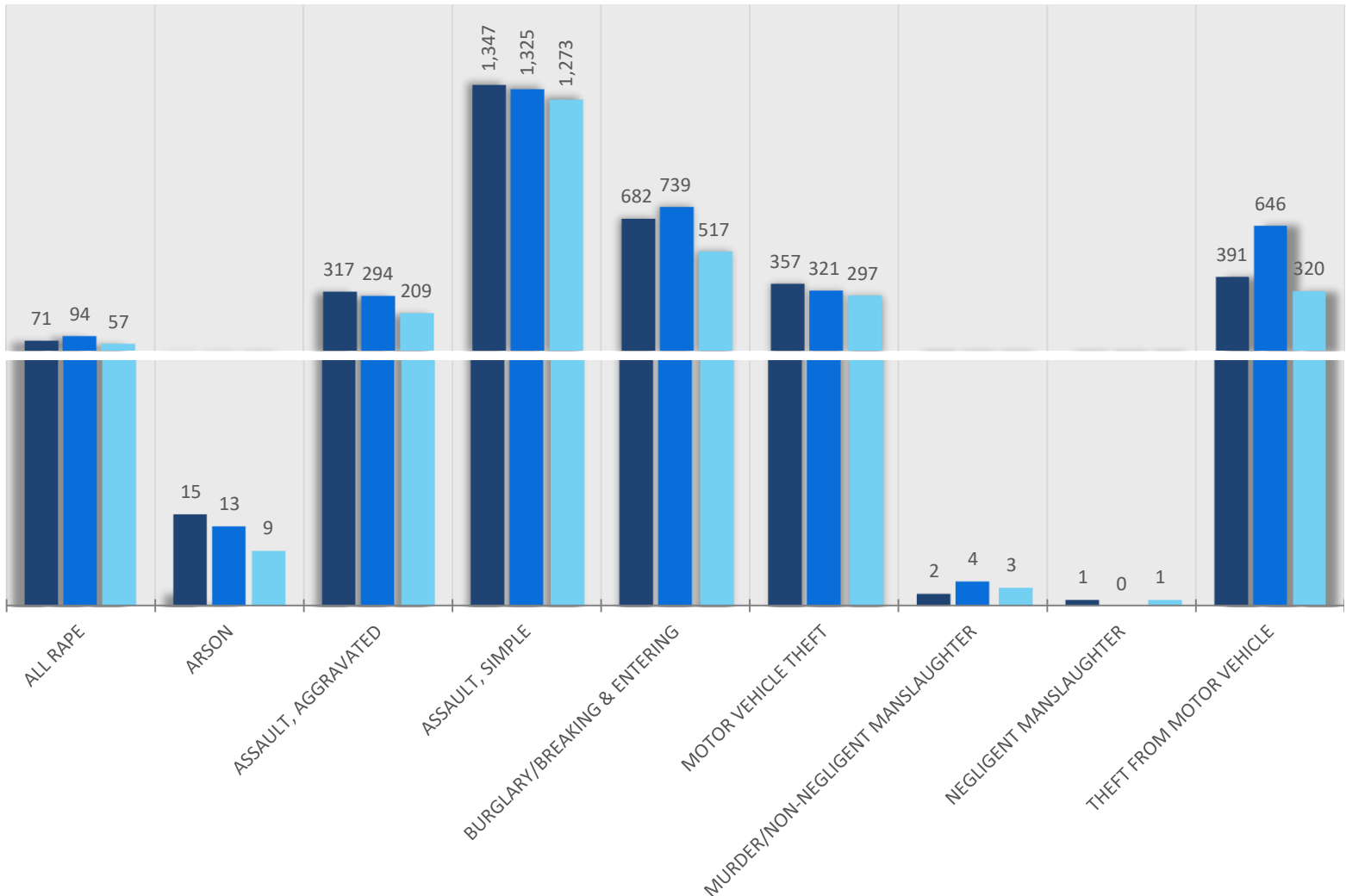

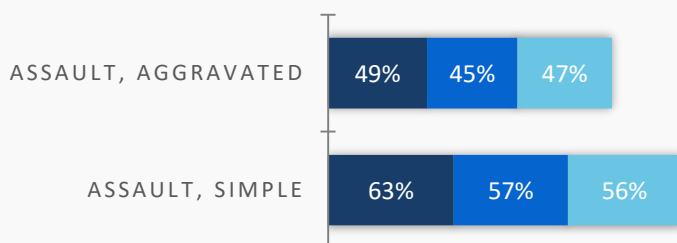
COUNT OF FARGO PD CASES PER OFFENSE CATEGORY

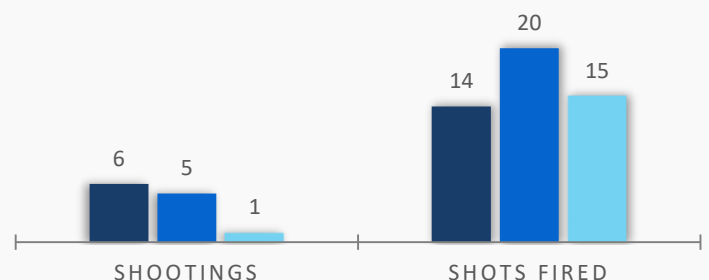
### PERCENTAGE OF ASSAULTS THAT WERE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RELATED

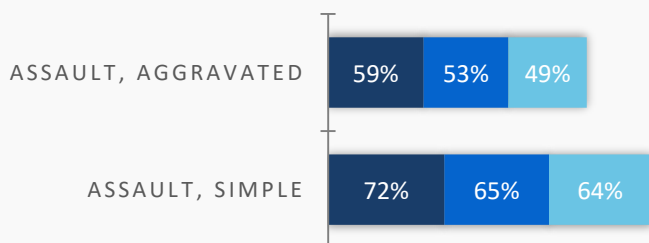
COUNT OF FARGO PD CASES PER OFFENSE CATEGORY

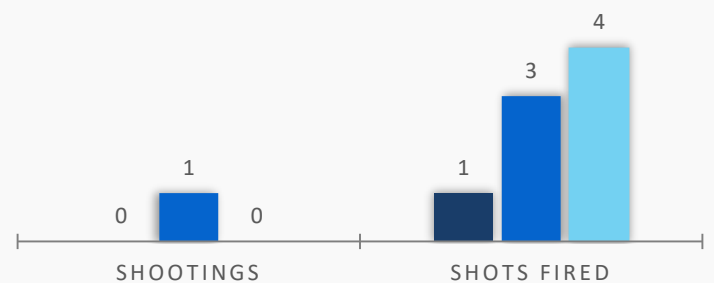
### PERCENTAGE OF ASSAULTS THAT WERE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RELATED

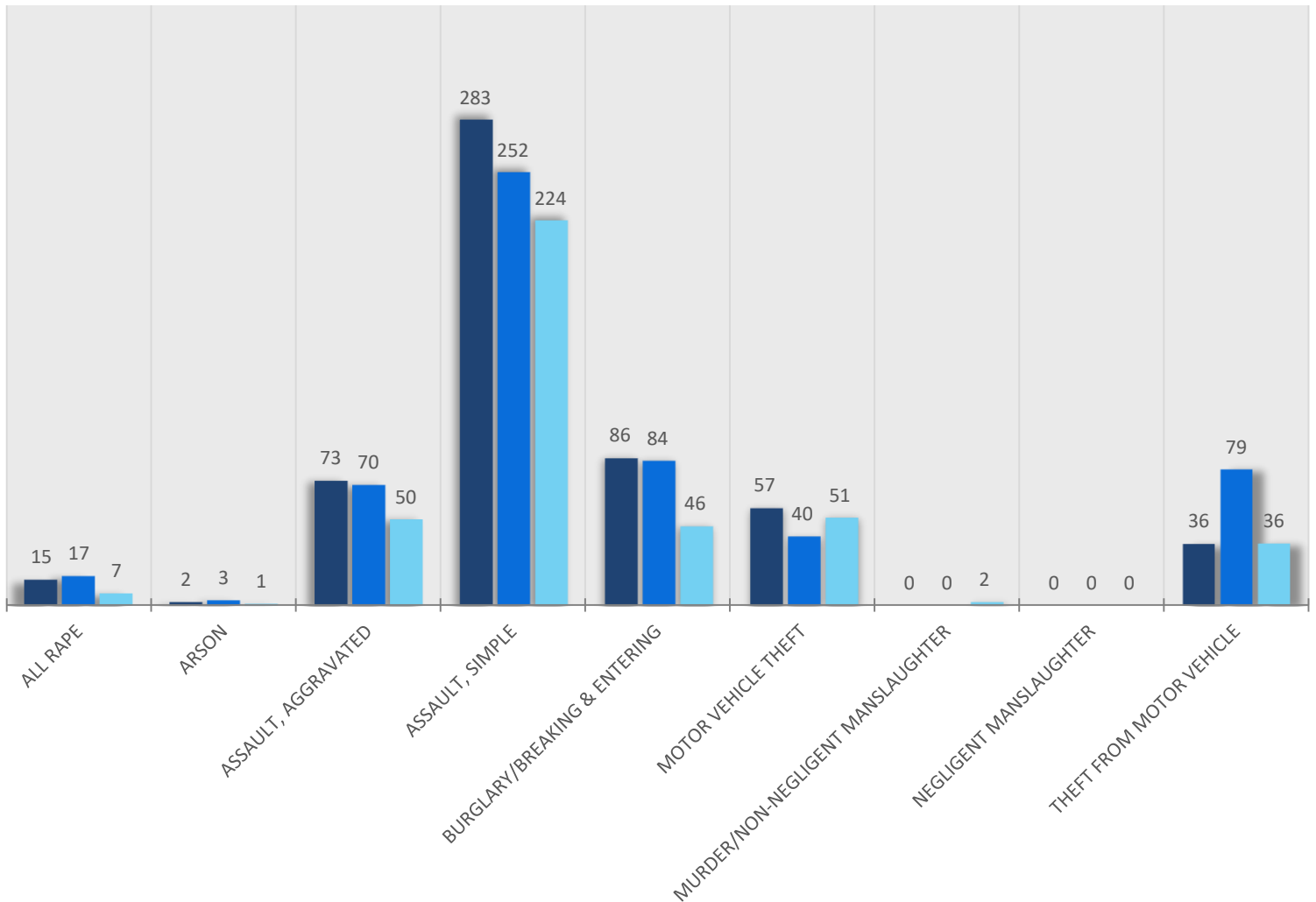

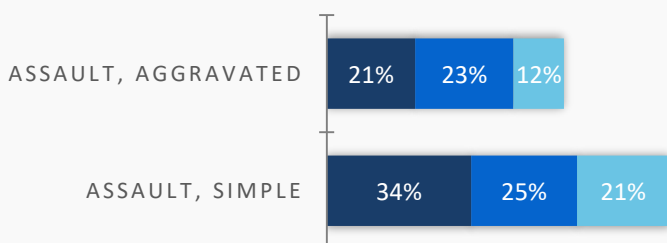
COUNT OF FARGO PD CASES PER OFFENSE CATEGORY

■ YTD 2023 ■ YTD 2024 ■ YTD 2025



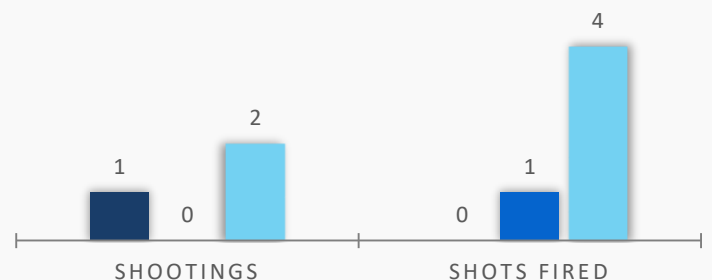
### PERCENTAGE OF ASSAULTS THAT WERE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RELATED

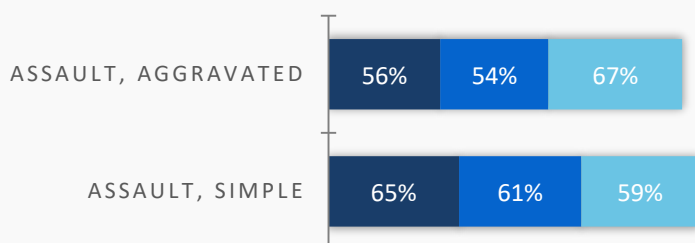
COUNT OF FARGO PD CASES PER OFFENSE CATEGORY

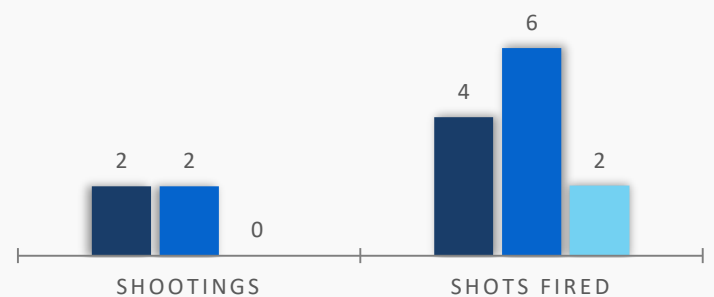
### PERCENTAGE OF ASSAULTS THAT WERE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RELATED

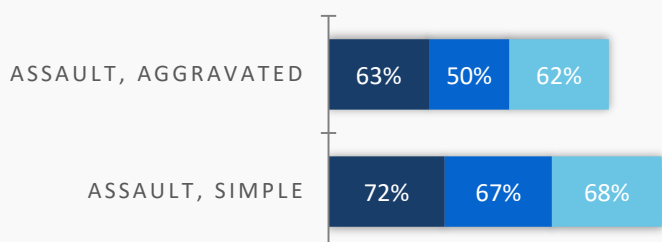
COUNT OF FARGO PD CASES PER OFFENSE CATEGORY

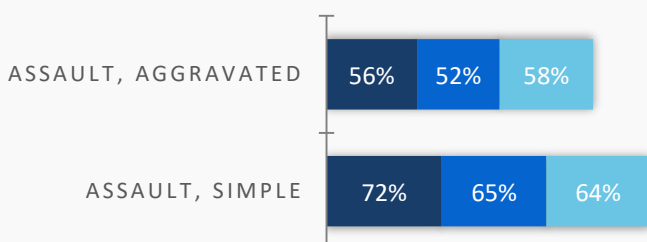
COUNT OF FARGO PD CASES PER OFFENSE CATEGORY

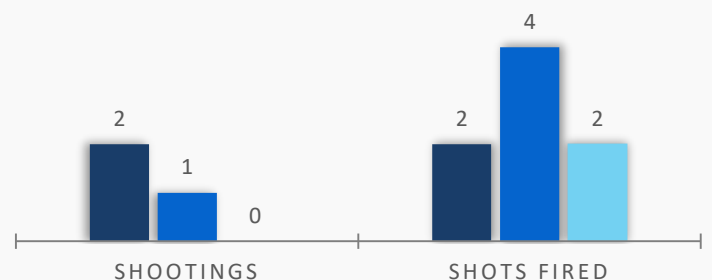

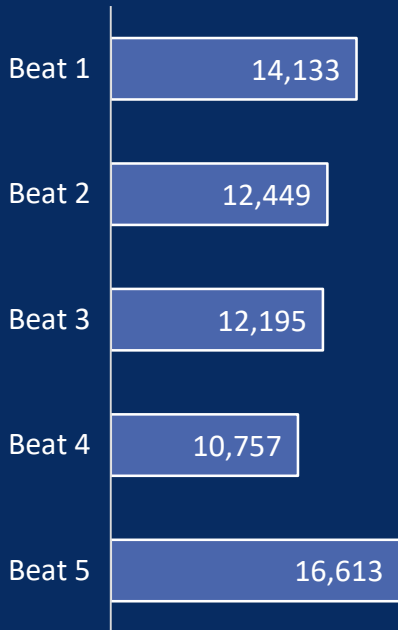




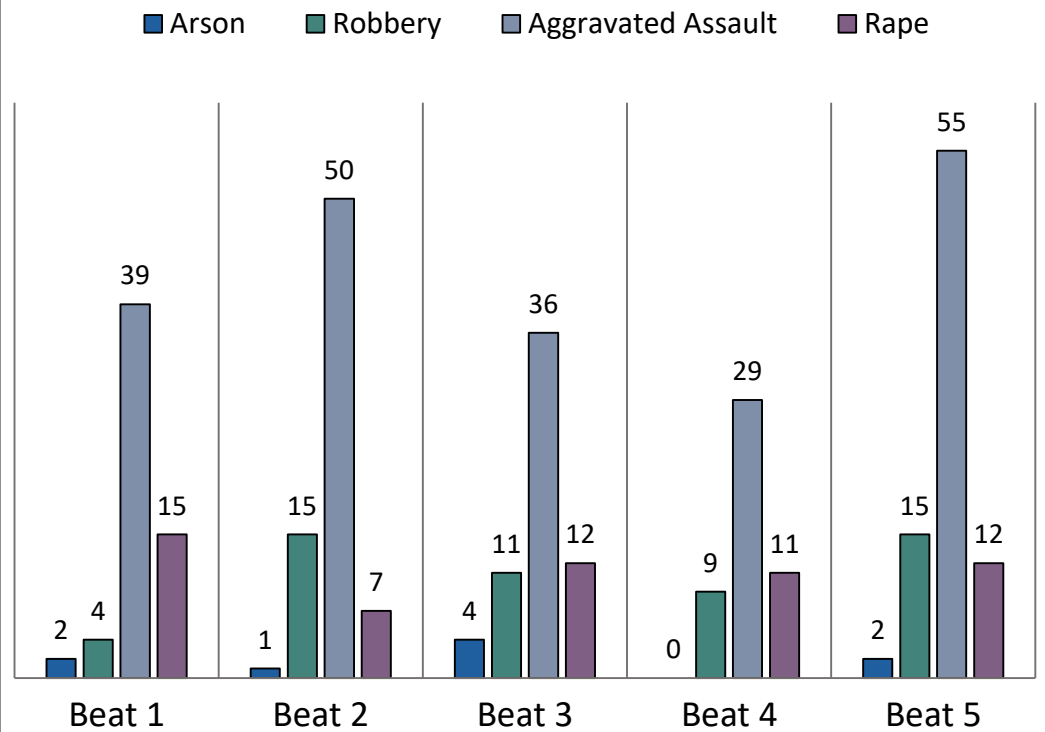
