 - o Team members have all been trained in Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM)
 - o Assist other agencies with Defusing and Debriefing incidents during Critical Incidents
 - o Defusing conducted after a critical incident before officer go home
 - o Debriefing more formal than Defusing, conducted 24-48 hours after the event
 - Mentoring and Family Sessions
- VALOR Training Resilience (by Sergeant Jesseca White)
 - Learned optimism
 - Avoid thinking traps
 - o Real-time resilience
 - o Signature character strengths
 - o Energy self-assessment
 - Gratitude
 - Joy multiplier
 - o IDEAL model
- Struggle Well (by Sergeant Matt Siders)
 - o Post-traumatic growth: "We grow through what we go through"
 - Wellness Triangle mind, body, finances, spirit
