Presentation: Dr. Donald Warne, Chair and Associate Professor with the Department of Public Health at North Dakota State University presenting on Center for American Indian Trauma

- Historical trauma, Prenatal Stress, Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE)
- Looking for 50-60 Native American families to participate in studies including biological samples, questionnaire regarding trauma, and screening for negative health consequences within Native American populations
- Findings could lead to health developments to reduce ACEs
- Culturally-appropriate disposal of bio samples Center for American Indian Trauma Research would handle the samples based on the individuals' wishes and could be destroyed by burning and/or blessing them
- Confidentiality all samples will be kept confidential. The only way to have it linked to the individual would require permission and that information would be kept in a locked box.
- Enrolling participants Ask for volunteers through typical networks, looking for multi-generational family participants with one person living in the F-M area.
- Time frame Proposal due middle of January, review over spring/summer, notification in fall. Earliest start date December 2017.
- Should Commissioner John Strand ask for support from City Commission/Mayor Mahoney? Helpful, yes by the first few weeks of January Letters from Native American Commission, City Commission, and Mayor would be helpful to show they have community support – John Strand is willing to put it on the City Commission agenda and speak with the Mayor.
- Questions or concerns should be sent to Willard. He will then send them on.
- Discussion or questions Everyone thanked Dr. Warne
- Motion by Sharon White Bear, Second by Connie Longie: To authorize Clinton to write a letter of support for the NDSU Centers of Biomedical Research Excellence application, and also request Commissioner John Strand to request a letter of support for the NDSU Centers of Biomedical Research Excellence application from the Fargo City Commission.
- The approval letter will be ready in the first few weeks of January 2017.

- Indian Education funding change Every Student Succeeds Act, Indian Education is now under Title 6, changing bylaws and will have community seats
