

Fargo Police Department Internship Program



The Fargo Police Department Police Department Internship program exposes, educates, and involves students in day to day police operations. The internship program fosters student's interest in a law enforcement career and builds a mutual understanding between the student population and the police department. The students will acquire an understanding of law enforcement functions within their community, whether or not the student decides to enter the profession of law enforcement. The program strives to instill values in the student such as law abiding habits, attitudes, and practices as a contributing citizen of the community.

The Fargo Police Department Internship Program is an unpaid, eight week program that operates from June through July. Interns will be exposed to all three divisions of the police department and its specialty units. During the internship program, interns will be required to complete weekly reflection journals on their activities, and complete a final reflection paper at the end of the program which describes in detail their experience and what they learned throughout their time with the department.

Application and Selection Process

The minimum requirements for applicants are:

- Must be enrolled and in good standing with an accredited college or university.
- If enrolled in a four year program, must be entering their junior or senior year; or if enrolled in a two year program, must be entering their final year.
- Must possess a cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher.
- Must complete and submit the Fargo Police Department Internship Program
 Application along with a copy of their post-secondary education transcripts, a letter
 of recommendation from a post-secondary educator, and a one to two page essay
 describing why they want to be an intern with the Fargo Police Department and what
 they think is the most pressing issue in law enforcement by April 26, 2019.

- Applicants will be notified via e-mail regarding the status of their application.
- Oral Interviews will be offered to those meeting the minimum qualifications that will occur during the week of **May 6-10, 2019**.
- The applicant chosen for the internship program must successfully pass a criminal history check and drug screening prior to a full internship offer.

Internship Schedule

The internship schedule has been created to allow the intern an opportunity to be exposed to the various divisions and specialties throughout the department. The internship schedule has been organized to assist in both intern schedule consistency and to maximize exposure and learning.

The intern will be assigned a project during their orientation. This project can be chosen by the intern in an area of their interest, or it can be directed by the internship program coordinator. The project portion of the internship program allows the intern to use and further develop what they have learned in the classroom and apply it to a police department setting.

- Orientation of the internship program, assignment of intern project, tours of the facilities, and the equipment with the Quartermaster (9 a.m. to Noon)
- Exposure to the Evidence and Property Unit (4 hours TBD)
- Exposure to the Records Unit (4 hours TBD)
- Exposure to the Recruiting and Training Unit (4 hours TBD)
- Red River Regional Dispatch Center (4 hours TBD)

Week 2 (6/10/19-6/15/19):

• Exposure to specialty positions including the Community Trust Officers (9 a.m. to 3 p.m.); Cultural Liaison Officer (9 a.m. to 3 p.m.); School Resource Officer (4 hours TBD); and Downtown Resource Officers (9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and 5 to 10 p.m. days TBD)

Week 3 (6/17/19-6/22-19):

• Fargo Police Community Picnic (6/25/19 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.); Crime Prevention & Public Information (4 hours TBD); Internship Project Assignment; Crime Analyst/ILP/Intelligence Unit (8 a.m. to 4 p.m.)

• Field Services Division Day Shift to include the Community Service Officers (1 p.m. to 5 p.m. days TBD)
