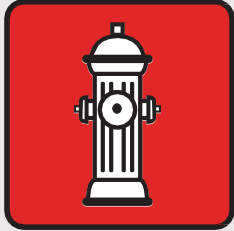

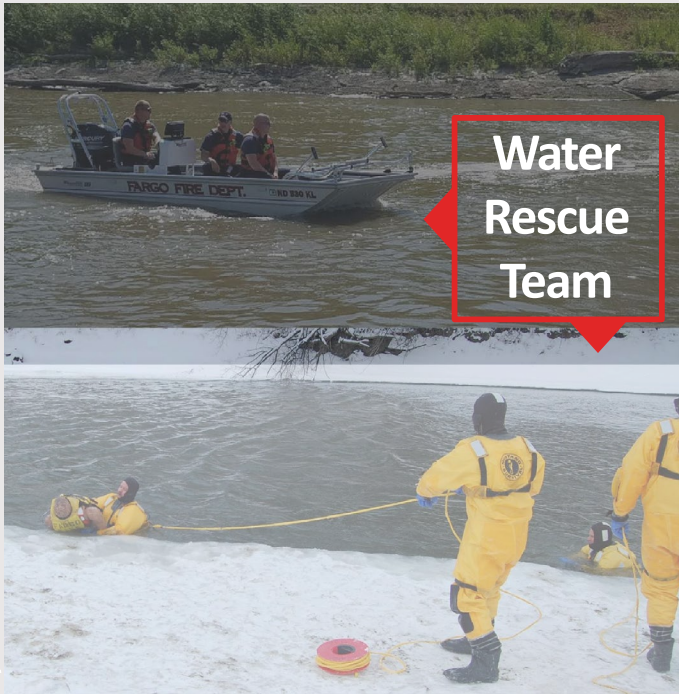

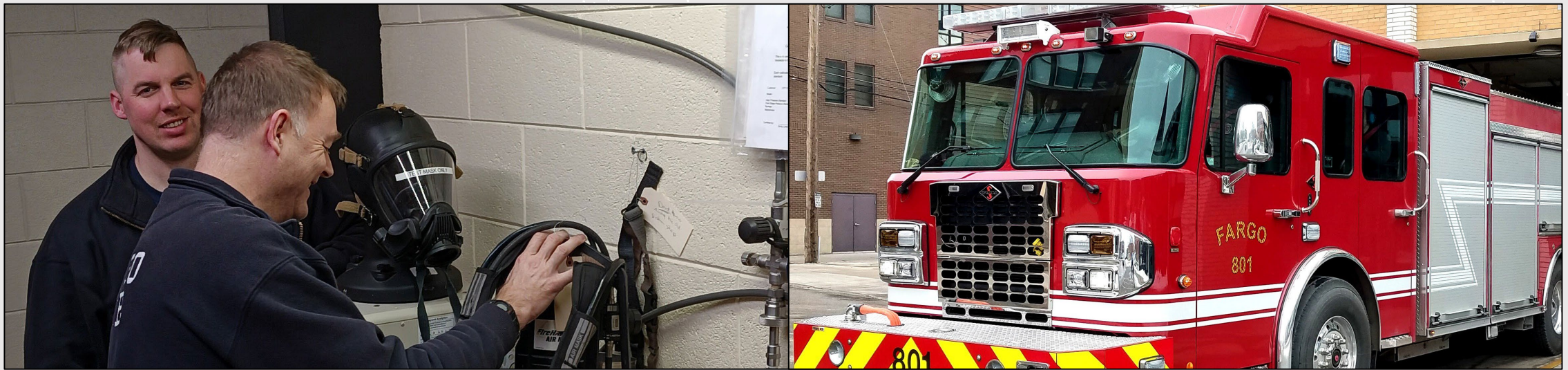

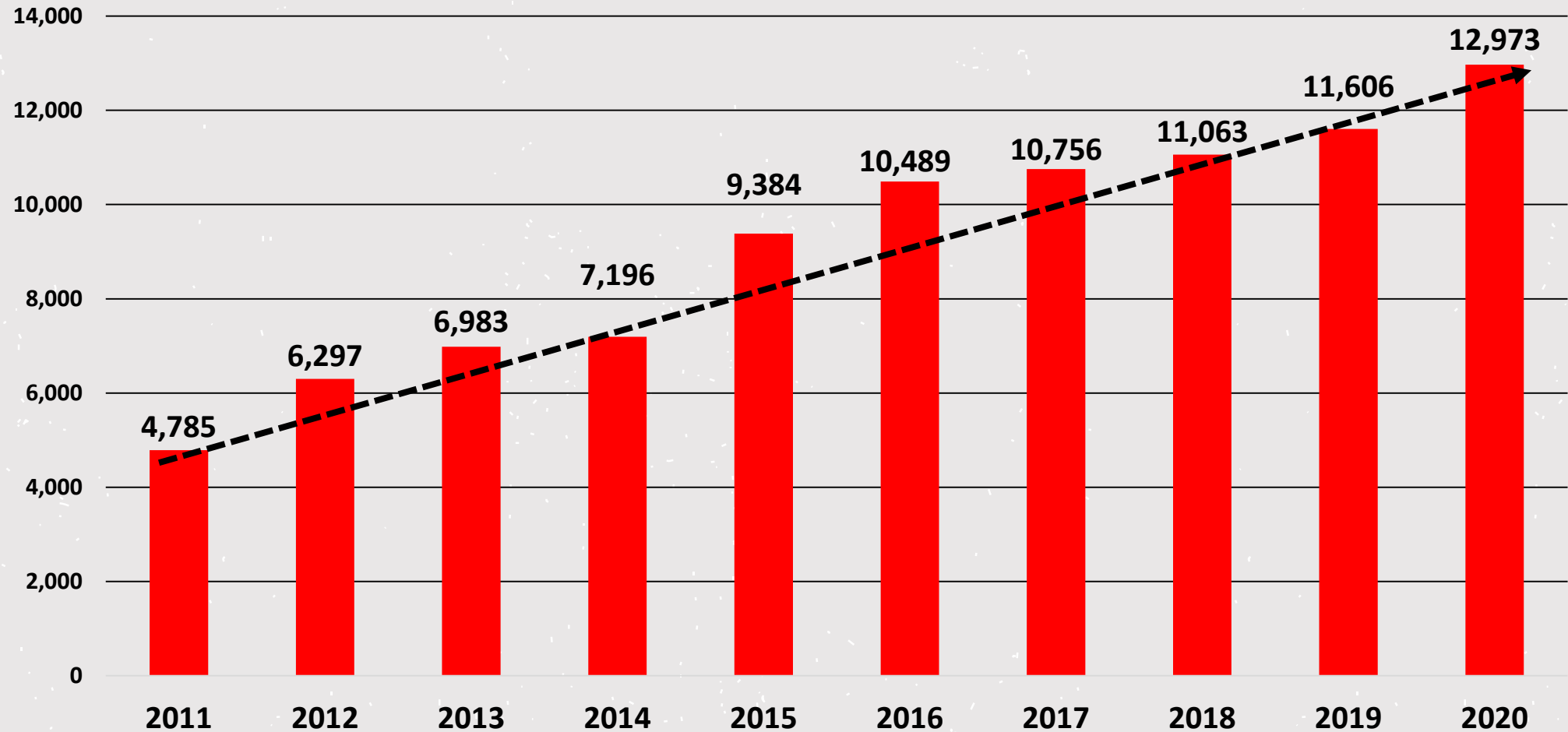

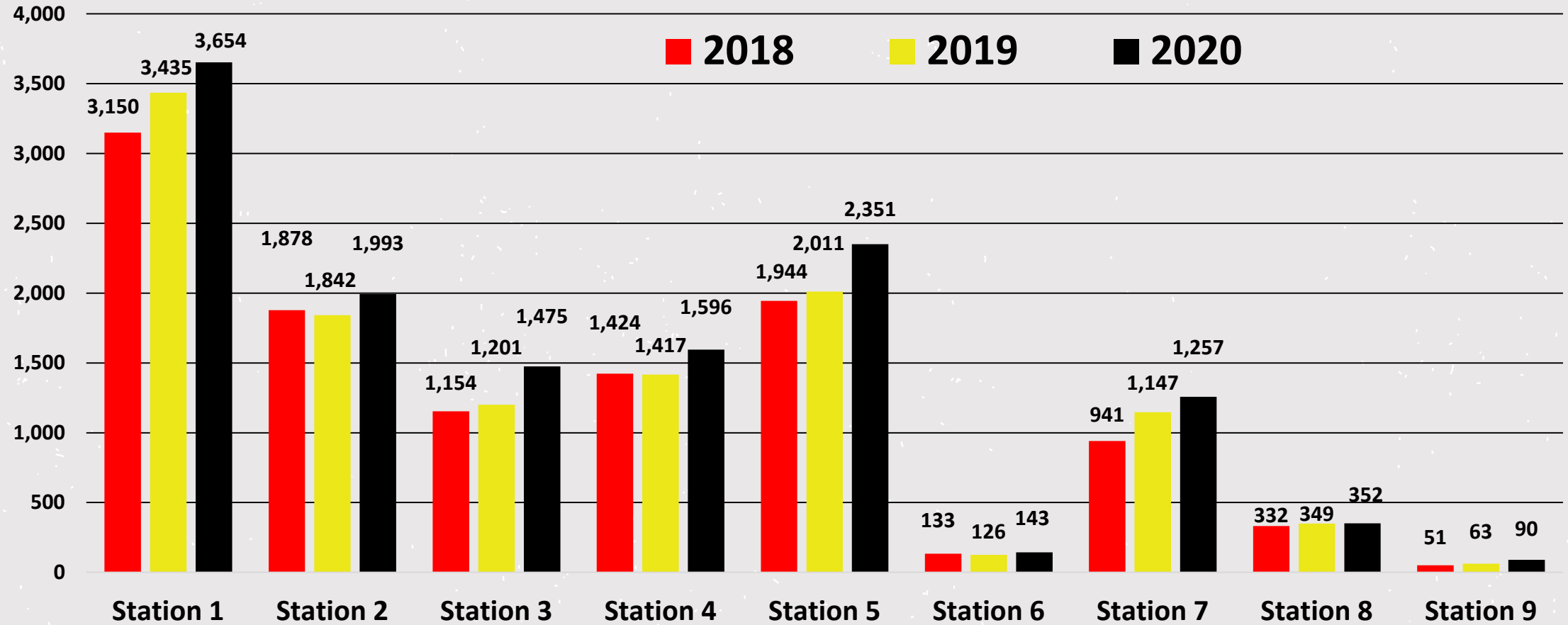

CALLS FOR SERVICE IN THE PAST TEN YEARS



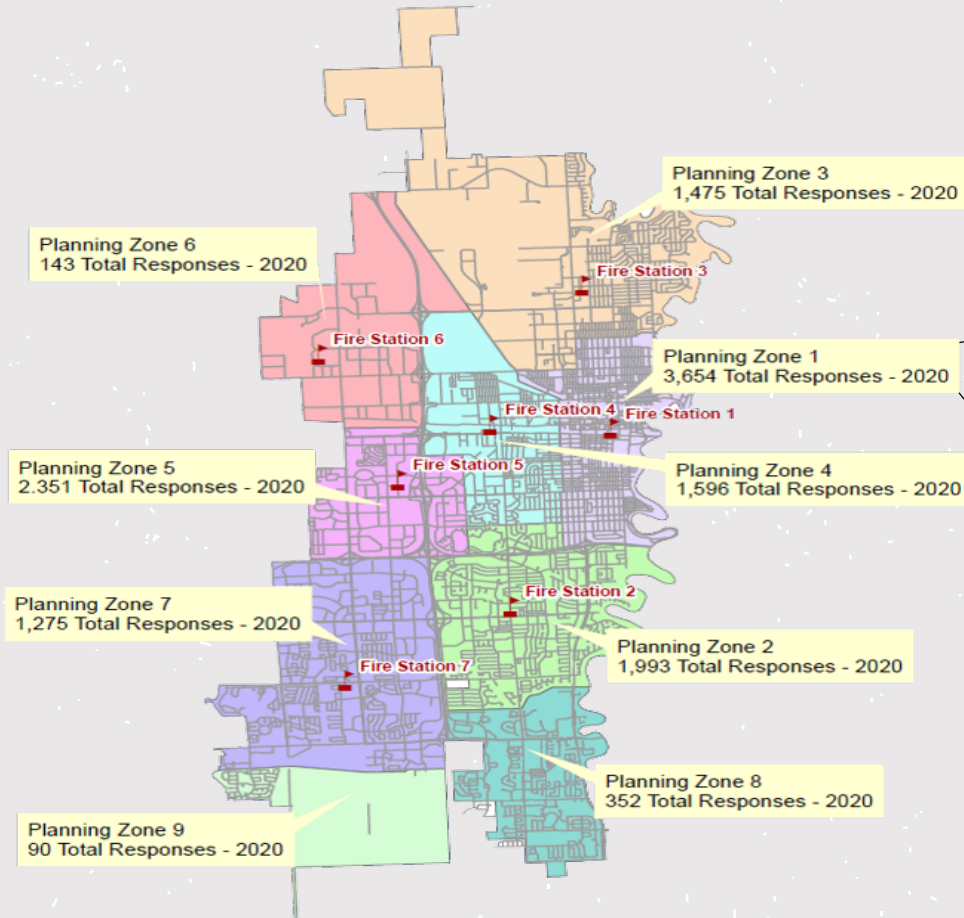
RESPONSES BY PLANNING ZONE 2018-2020



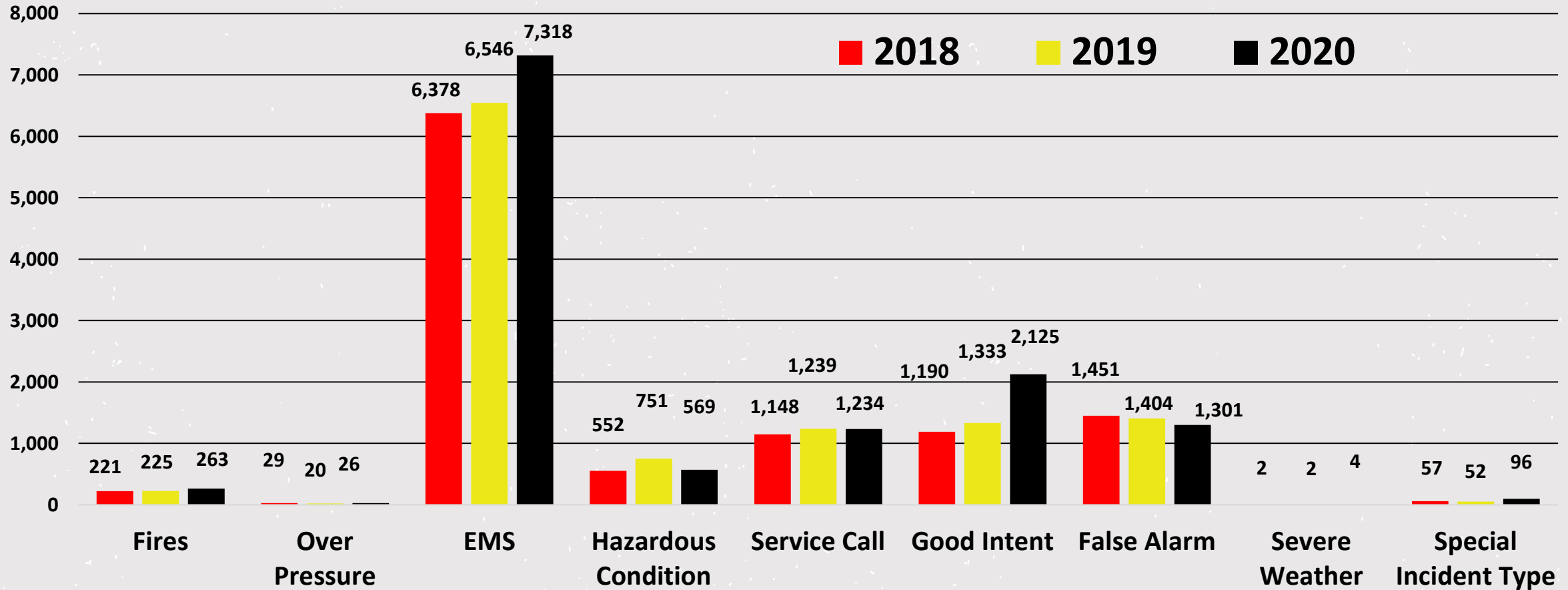
CITY OF FARGO PLANNING ZONES



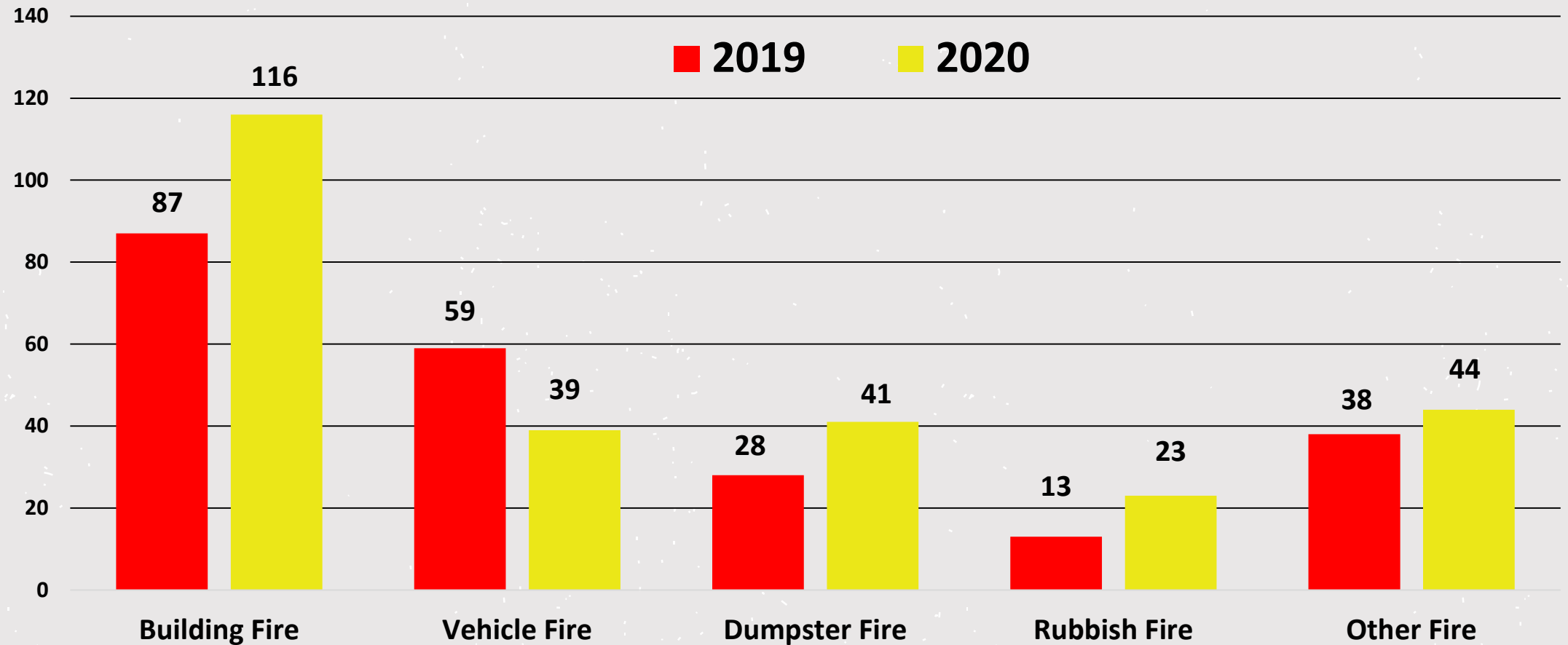
Fire Station 1 in

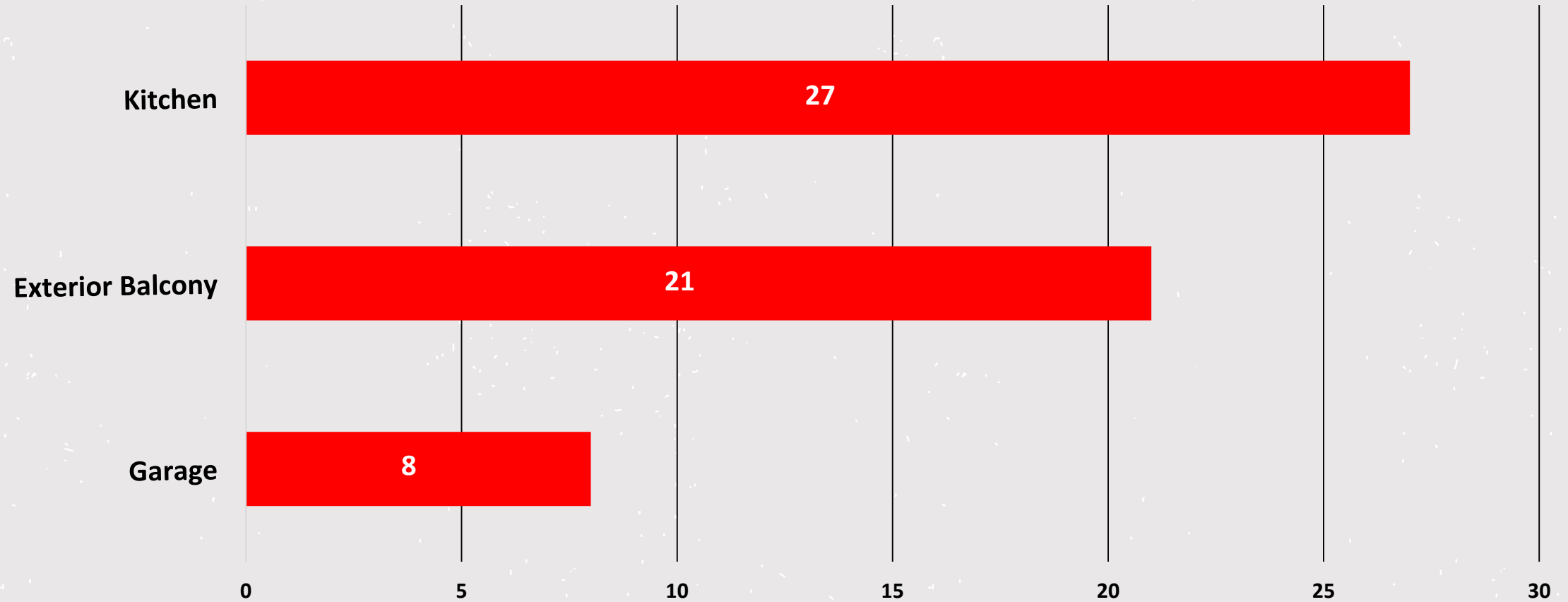
NUMBER OF RESPONSES BY TYPE (2018-2020)



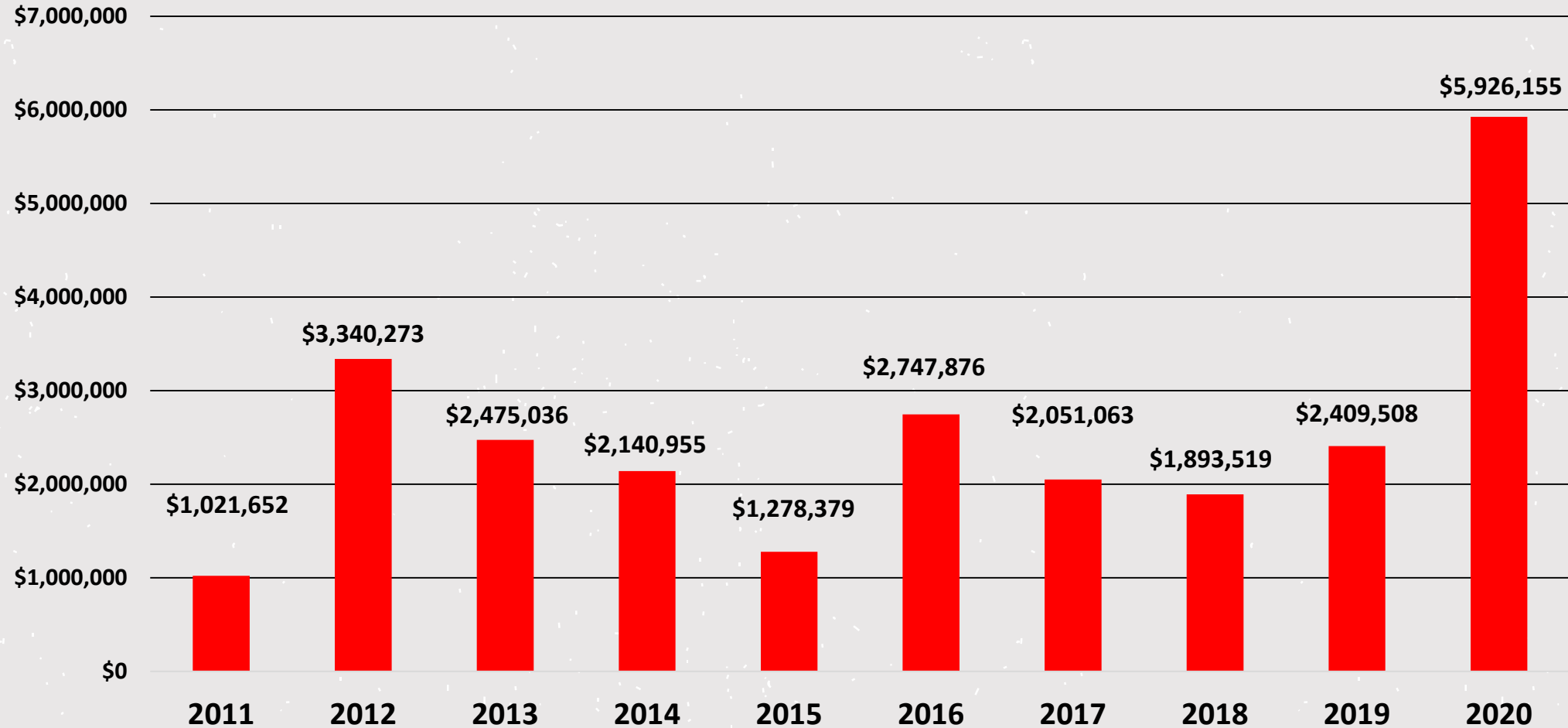
MOST COMMON TYPES OF FIRE (2019-2020)



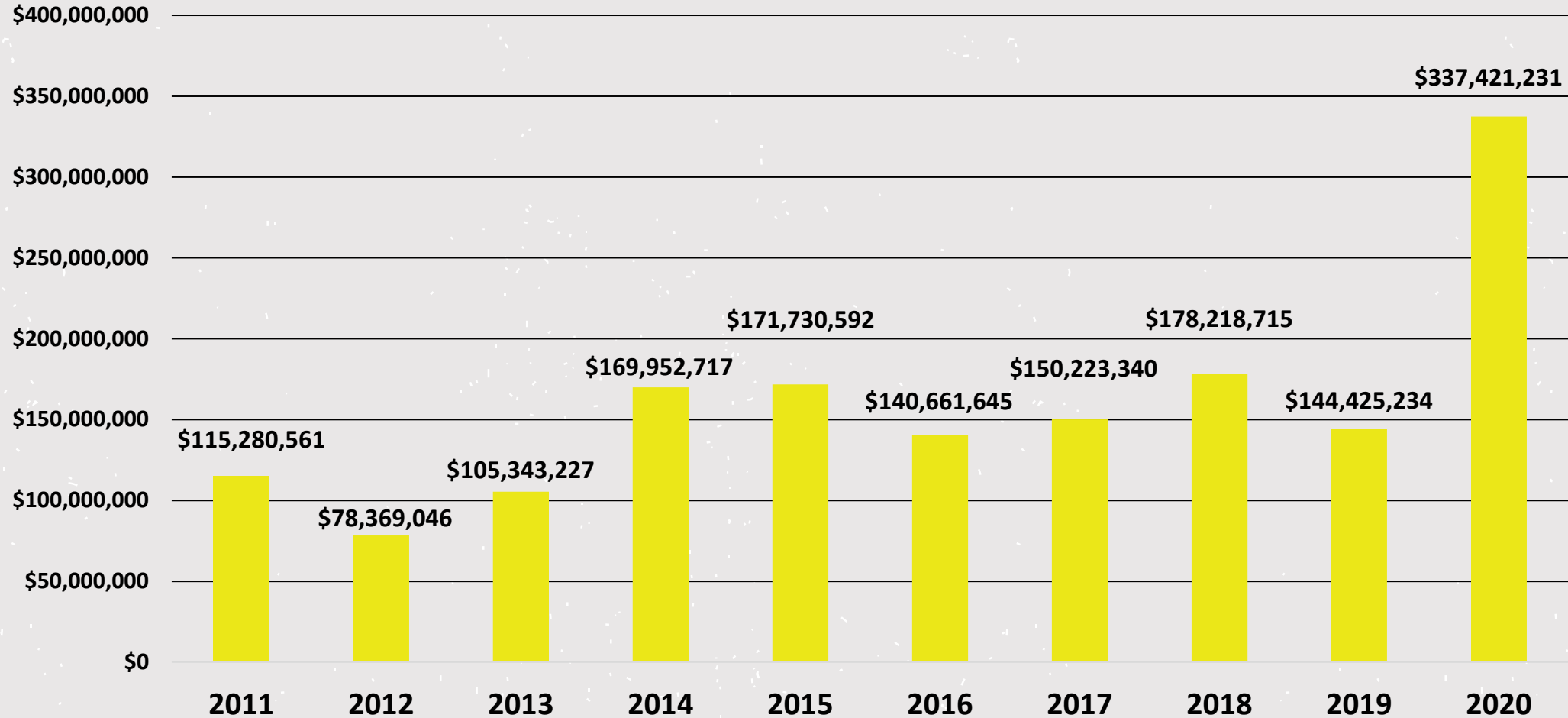
MOST COMMON STRUCTURE FIRE ORIGINS



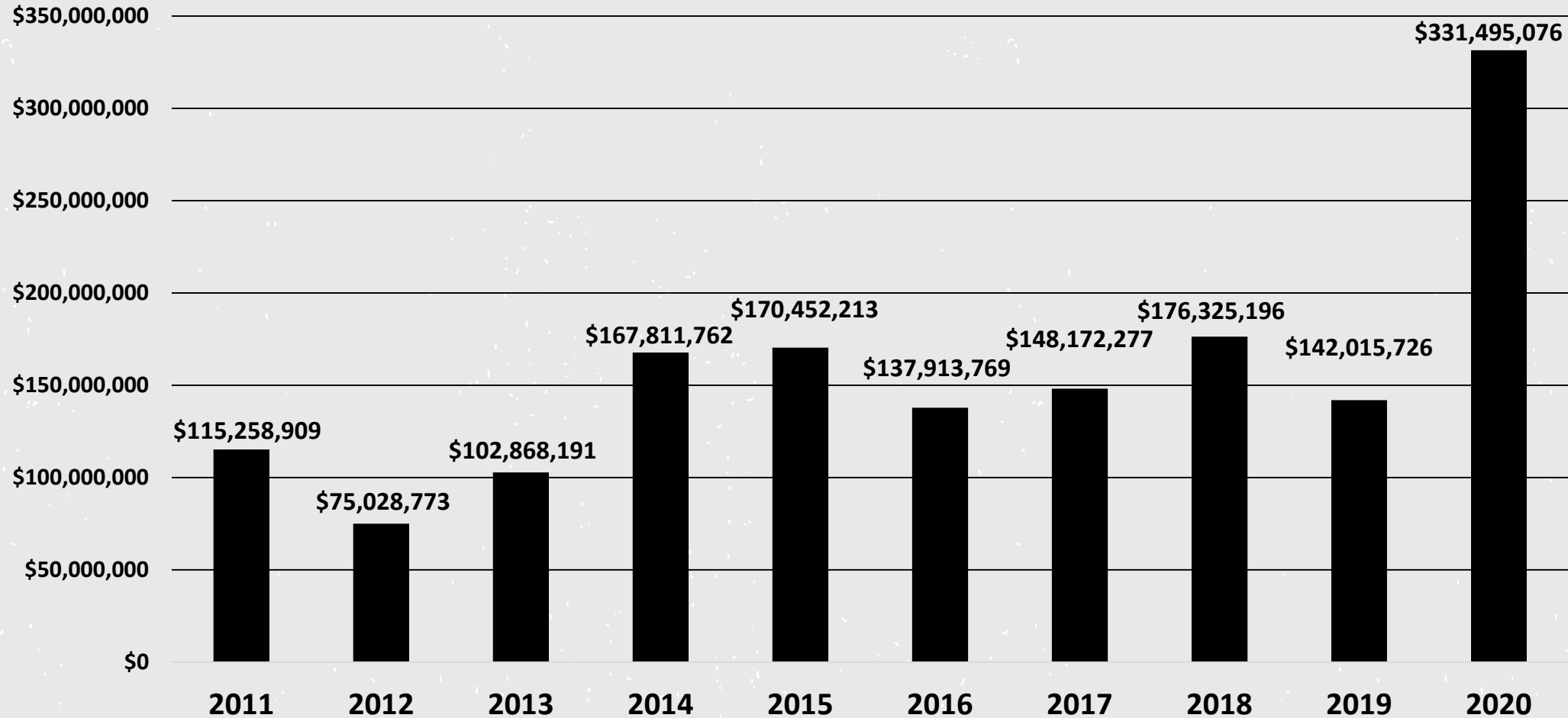
TOTAL FIRE LOSS (DOLLAR VALUE)



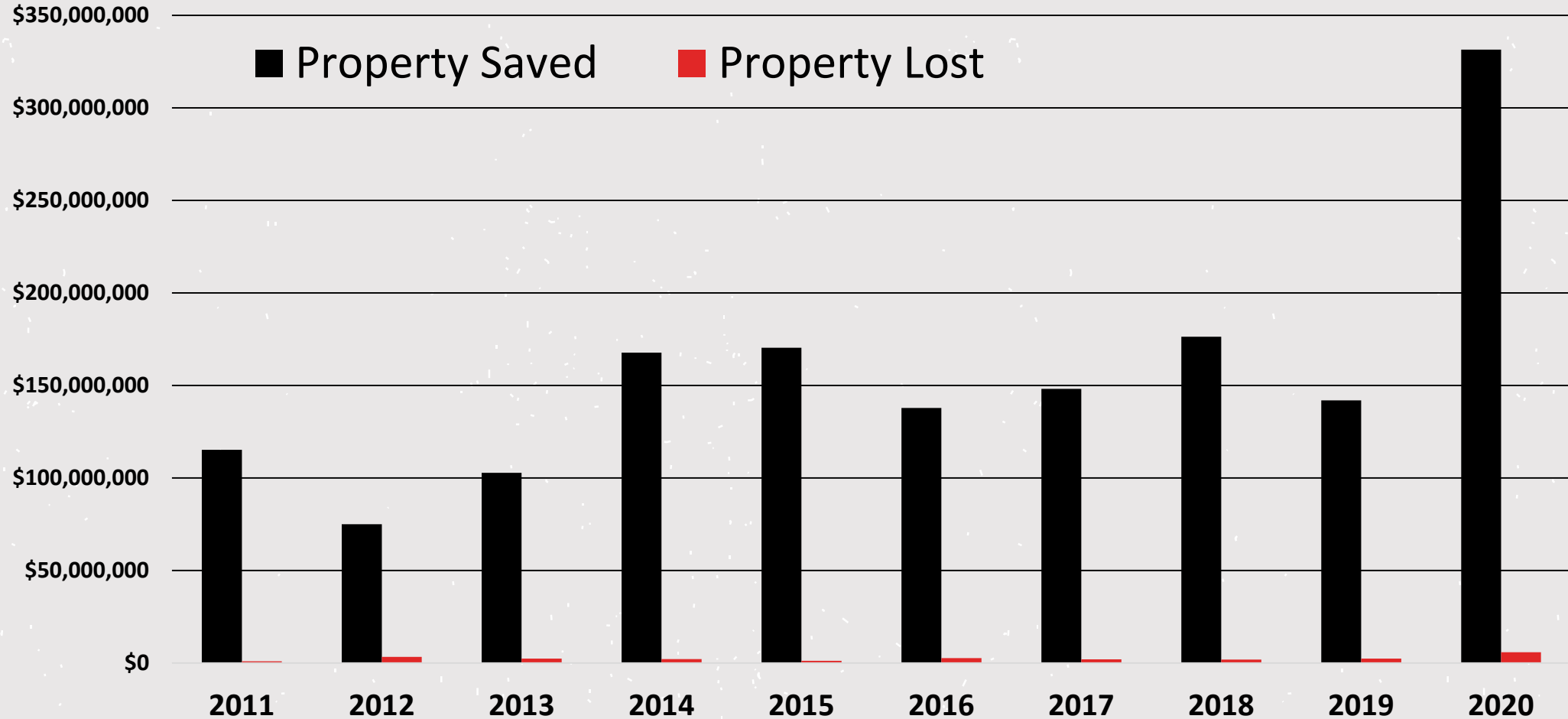
TOTAL PRE-INCIDENT VALUE (DOLLAR VALUE)



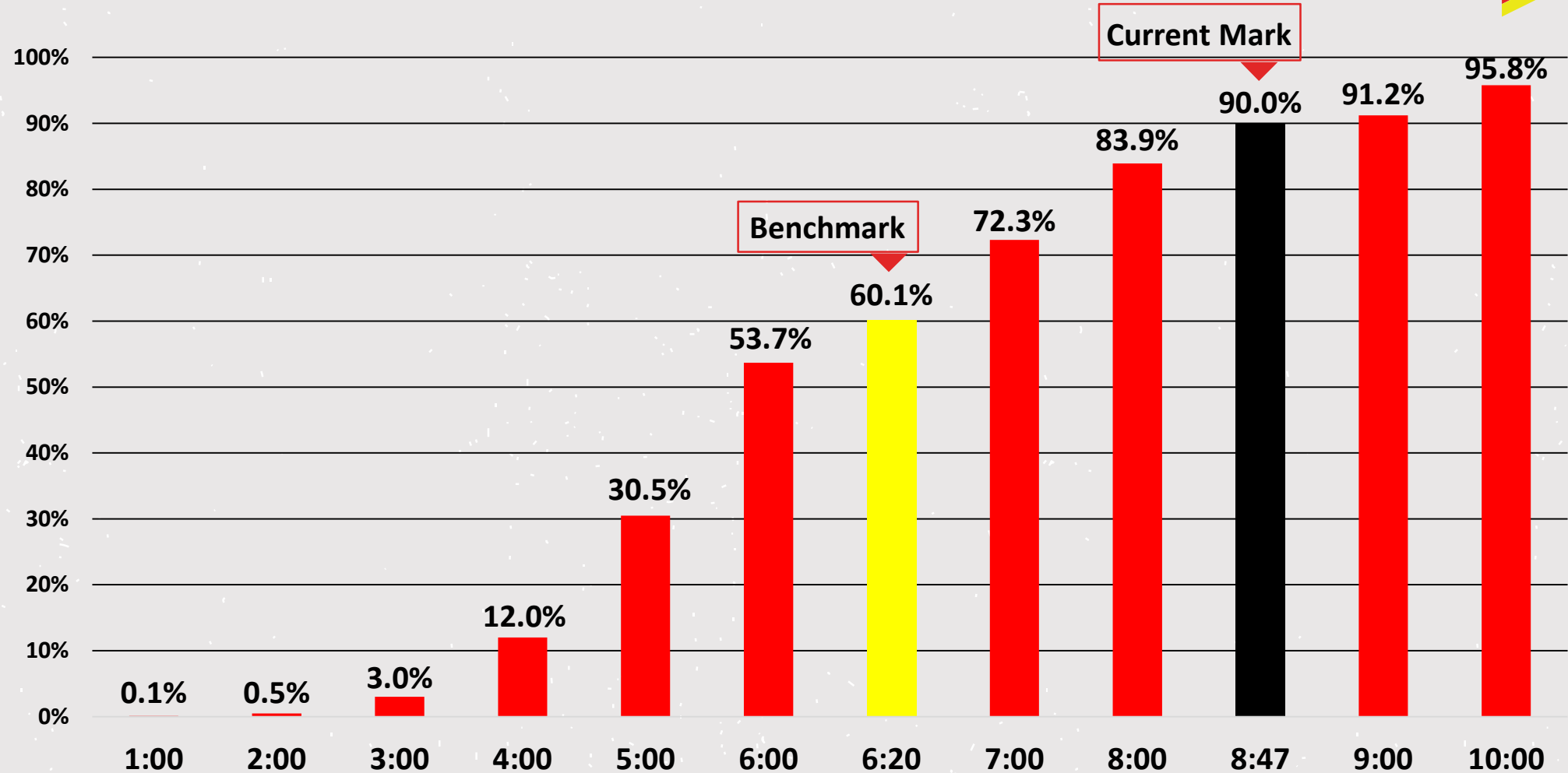
TOTAL PROPERTY SAVED (DOLLAR VALUE)



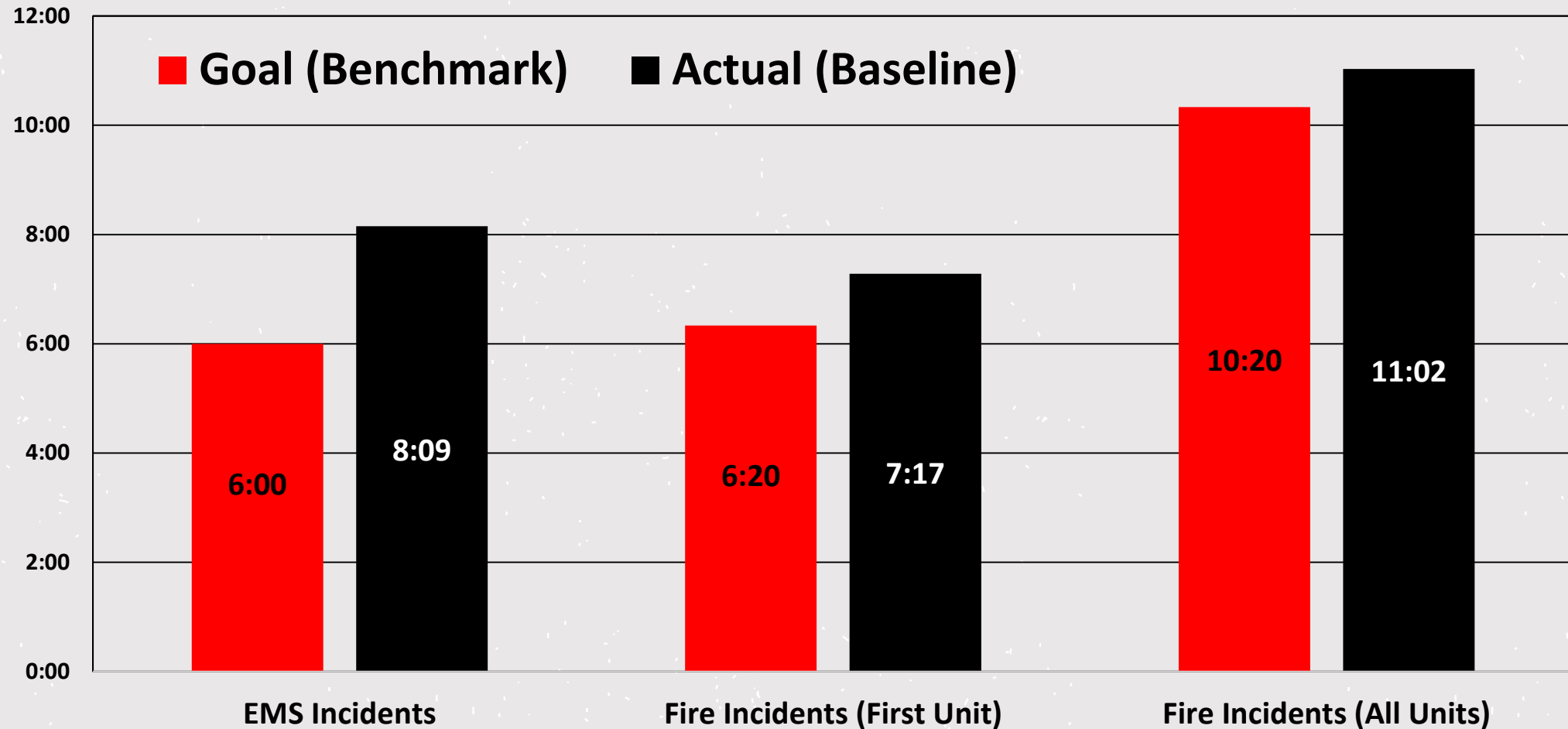
TOTAL PROPERTY SAVED VS. PROPERTY LOST

2020 MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS



- » Received Accredited Agency status for the third time from the Commission on Fire Accreditation International
- » Retained ISO Class 1 Rating
- » No stations were closed due to COVID-19
- » Certified members of the HazMat, Tech Rescue and Water Rescue teams
- » Five members joined the Fargo Fire Department team in 2020

- » Developed virtual content to reach community with fire prevention messages
- » Continued to develop the Red River Valley Unmanned Aircraft Systems Group
