Meeting was called to order at 2:30 P.M.

1. Review Possible Liquor Violations

a. Determine possible liquor violations for Old Broadway: employment of minors in an liquor establishment in a non-excluded capacity and failure to have staff server trained. Steve Sprague presented. This incident was brought to attention after an incident that occurred at Old Broadway in which a security officer assaulted a person, it was discovered that one of the security guards was under 21 years of age and had not obtained server training. Section 25-1511 in the Ordinance states mandatory server training, while 25-1509 lists excluded jobs from server training, food waiter/waitress/busgirl/busboy. Warren Ackley, owner/manager of Old Broadway for 46 years was present and stated in this isolated incident there was an individual who did not follow procedure to obtain server training, new procedures have been put into place to ensure this will not happen in the future. Employment of a person under 21 the Code does not include, door person, cooks, dishwashers, bar backs, they are not involved with serving, pouring, delivering alcohol beverages. Warren feels the Code should include these positions and be updated due to antiquated terms such as busboy/busgirl/waitress. Due to the ambiguous terms in the Code it makes it difficult to hire certain positions.

Suggested Motion: Move to find the Old Broadway violated Fargo Municipal Code Chapter 25-1511 and 25-1509 by employing a minor and not providing server training. Administrative penalty is \$500.00 per violation. Commissioner Piepkorn asked if the City Ordinance server training section can be modified so they all match up. City Attorney Nance Morris stated the Ordinance does state that server training must be completed before the employee participates in the stream of service. As far as the underage door attendant the Ordinance does state no one under the age of 21 shall enter except as provided in Sections C & D, which is consistent with State law, to make changes would require state Legislature change, she does agree with antiquated language, in her opinion this position would be required to be 21 years of age. Stibbe made the motion that Old Broadway violated Fargo Municipal Code by not requiring server training.

Moved Stibbe Second Nelson Passed Unanimously

b. Determine possible liquor violations for the Windbreak serving obviously intoxicated or impaired persons, Fargo Municipal Code 25-1509.2. Chief Zibolski presented along with Sargent Golos, Sgt. Golos serves as the liason for Windbreak. Chief Zibolski stated that since September they have 16 over intoxication incidents. Sgt. Golos stated he has been the Windbreak liason for 1 ½ -2 years, which involves him reviewing any call at the establishment, he will review their security footage as it pertains to a specific situation. This particular incident involved a female that was arrested for a DUI outside of the Windbreak. BAC was just under .3, she later contacted police stating her drink may have been tampered with, but that was not found to be the case.

August 18, 2023 10:47 ID check, wristband purchased, appears fine at that point 10:55 first drink.

11:10 second drink.

In between drinks she is talking to other people and taking sips of their drinks 11:37 Windbreak employee walks her to the smoking area and makes a drink in a "beer" glass, does not charge her for this drink.

11:47 pool area, orders another drink paid for by gentleman, now has 2 drinks, goes to the dance floor and dances by herself, very exaggerated.

Midnight appears intoxicated on the dance floor, puts her head on the stage in a resting position.

12:36 a gentleman takes her to the bar and orders 3 drinks, she is all over the gentleman, he gets a beer a shot and a drink, she does the shot and drink, she passes out at the table and security comes over with a bottle of water, she needs assistance to walk out.

She leaves just before 1am and the accident occurred around 2am.

Tim O'Keefe was present. He pointed out that the Windbreak is more of a destination establishment, meaning you do have to drive there and the staff does a good job of trying to help people not drive away, they also have security cameras and take security very seriously. The employees of the Windbreak have all been server trained. O'Keefe mentioned that the female took one drink to the smoking area, where there is no camera, she came in without it and went out to her car, appeared fine when she came back in. 2 drinks were purchased for her by other patrons, she did appear to be drinking from other peoples drinks. The Windbreak feels they did have adequate staff for this particular evening. After security took the drinks away and brought her water and she sat for a while, they assisted her out and tried to get her a cab or Uber. She sat in her car and became belligerent and refused to tell them if she had an Uber coming. O'Keefe stated that during the times she was in her car the Windbreak staff would not know what she was doing at those times, he believes these are important factors. Key

words in the Ordinance are you can't serve someone who is "obviously intoxicated". The Windbreak feels they has adequate staff and training, when it was recognized that she was intoxicated they took appropriated measures to remover her from the establishment. They ask that the board does not find the Windbreak in violation. City Attorney Nancy Morris stated that according the Ordinance, the officer's recitation of the facts that were found on the video. Chief Zibolski wanted to bring to the boards attention that this is not an isolated incident.

Motion: Fine the establishment



Application for transfer of a class "FA-GOLF" Alcoholic Beverage License from Kjerbeersten, LLC d/b/a 19th Hole at Rose Creek to Up North Hospitality, LLC d/b/a CJ's Tavern, Located at 1500 East Rose Creek Parkway S, Fargo.

In accordance with Section 25-1505 of the Fargo Municipal Code, I have conducted an investigation into the character, reputation and fitness of the applicant(s) listed on the supplied application.

During this investigation, I examined the applicants' credit reports and public record criminal backgrounds.

The following information was discovered through this investigation:

Townsend, Cody

Criminal History -

A search of Fargo Police Department criminal records, North Dakota public records (publicsearch.ndcourts.gov) and Minnesota public records (https://chs.state.mn.us)

showed no criminal history.

Credit History -

Townsend's credit history was reviewed. There are no prior bankruptcies, recent past due

accounts or debts turned over to collections.

Erpelding, Jordan

Criminal History -

A search of Fargo Police Department criminal records, North Dakota public records (publicsearch.ndcourts.gov) and Minnesota public records (https://chs.state.mn.us) showed he received an open container citation in 2014. This charge was disclosed on his application.

Credit History -

Jordan Erpelding's credit history was reviewed. There are no prior bankruptcies, or debts turned over to collections. Jordan has two credit card accounts that show they are currently 30 days delinquent. However, the monthly notation shows the delinquencies were 1-2 years ago and both accounts are current with one having zero balance.

Erpelding, Brett

Criminal History -

A search of Fargo Police Department criminal records, North Dakota public records (publicsearch.ndcourts.gov) and Minnesota public records (https://chs.state.mn.us) show Brett Erpelding was arrested for a DUI in June of 2012. Brett was also issued a citation for driving under suspension on the same day. Brett disclosed the DUI on the application (he indicates it happened in 2013) but does not mention the DUS citation. Brett disclosed that his driver's license was suspended after the DUI arrest, but it must have also been suspended at the time of the arrest to receive the citation. ND public records shows this DUS citation was dismissed. Both police records and ND public records show Brett pled guilty to "smoking in a prohibited location" in 2015. According to the case report, Brett was an employee at E-Cig Empire and his friends were smoking inside of the shop during business hours. This charge is a criminal infraction in ND. This charge was not disclosed on the application.

Credit History -

Brett Erpelding's credit history was reviewed. There are no prior bankruptcies, or debts turned over to collections. Brett Erpelding has two accounts that were 30 days past due, but are now both current.

Erpelding, Bradley

Criminal History -

A search of Fargo Police Department criminal records, North Dakota public records (publicsearch.ndcourts.gov) and Minnesota public records (https://chs.state.mn.us) showed Bradley was arrested for a DUI in 2000. This charge was disclosed on the application. North Dakota public record also shows Bradley received a "hunting without non-resident license" in 1996. The disposition is listed as "deferred dismissal".

Credit History -

Bradley Erpelding's credit history was reviewed. There are no recent past due accounts or debts turned over to collections. Bradley disclosed on his application that he filed for bankruptcy about 15 years ago. This bankruptcy did not show up on my credit report.

Investigation Notes

This application is for the transfer of a class "A-GOLF" alcoholic beverage license (Authorizes the licensee to sell beer, wine, and spirits, on sale only and located on a 9 hole or more USGA golf course. A bar is allowed and 25% of sales must be from food from April-October, and 50% of sales must be from food from November-March) from Kjerbeersten, LLC d/b/a 19th Hole at Rose Creek to Up North Hospitality, LLC d/b/a CJ's Tavern.

I spoke with Brett Erpelding over the phone with regards to the missing information on his application. I told him I found some criminal charges that were not disclosed on his application. I brought up the smoking in a public space charge. Brett responded asking if it was 2007. I said it was from 2015 and asked if he remembered the charge. Brett said he did not. I read him the circumstances from the police report and added that the charge would have required him to appear in court and Brett said he still doesn't remember, but said he probably did it. I also asked Brett if his driver's license has ever been suspended other than the DUI noted on the application. Brett said it probably was from driving without insurance. This would explain the DUS citation issued during the DUI arrest in 2012.

I asked Brett why these charges were not disclosed on the application. Brett said he did not fill out the application, adding that one of the other applicants, maybe Cody, must have filled it out for him. I asked if this co-applicant asked him for the correct information to put on the application for him and he said they did not, and they must have looked it up or just remembered the information. I followed up asking if he signed the documents that have his signature and he said he did, but couldn't remember what he signed exactly. A closer review all of the handwritten applications shows it's likely that all 4 applications were filled out by individual people, and the person who filled out Brett's portion did not complete any of the other paperwork.

I called Cody Townsend to talk about Brett's application. Cody said he received a text message from Brett after I talked to him saying Brett put the wrong date of his DUI in the application. I asked Cody if he filled out Brett's paperwork for him and he said he did not, and Brett did fill it out himself. Cody was not able to give an explanation of why Brett would have been untruthful about not completing the application, other than it's possible he did not remember filling it out.

Business Location

CJ's Tavern will be located at 1500 East Rose Creek Parkway S at the Rose Creek Golf Course. There are no other businesses with an alcoholic beverage license in the area.

Conclusion

David said he spent hours on the phone with the company to try and get it resolved, which was not successful. David said he was aware the account went to collections and would not settle with the credit companies when they contacted him due to him not agreeing with the debt.

Other businesses in the immediate area with alcoholic beverage licenses are Beer and Fish Company, Rosewild, Blackbird Wood Fire Pizza, Teddy's, and Dempsey's.
