



Plus numerous unpaid courses in Stop The Bleed, Hands Only CPR, etc.




OUR FLEET

- 3 Community Paramedic




OUR DISPATCH - 2025


- Processed 950 emergency requests by phone

HEAT MAP & POSTING PLAN






RESPONSE VOLUME HISTORY


Total Requests For Sanford Ambulance




EMERGENT RESPONSE PERFORMANCE



TOP 10 PRIMARY IMPRESSIONS



CARDIAC REGISTRY TO ENHANCE SURVIVAL (CARES)

2025 National Preliminary Data


- 41.9% received bystander CPR
- 13.7% had bystander applied AED
- 9.5% survived to hospital discharge
- Utstein = 30.3%
- Utstein Bystander = 33.9%
 - Bystander provided CPR and/or AED

2025 Preliminary Fargo Data

- 36.6% received bystander CPR
- **46.2% had bystander applied AED**
- 9.2% survived to hospital discharge
- Utstein = 30%
- Utstein Bystander = 28.6%
 - Bystander provided CPR and/or AED
