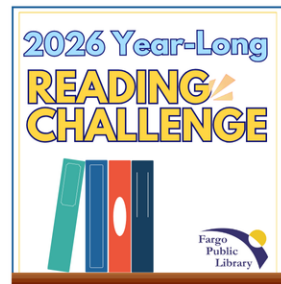
FOR KIDS & TEENS COLLEGE SAVE READING CHAMPIONS PROGRAM

VIRTUAL MEETING EQUIPMENT

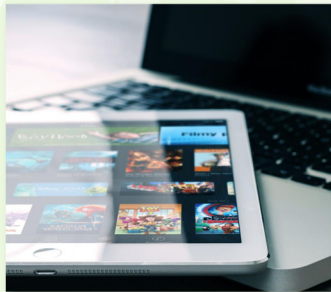
