LIBRARY CARDS

Who can get a Fargo Public Library Card?

A free Fargo Public Library card is available to:

- All Fargo residents.
- All Fargo property taxpayers with proof of identification and address.
- K-12 students in Fargo public or private schools whose residences may be outside the city limits.

You can also qualify for a free Fargo Public Library card if you live in the following areas:

- The West Fargo Public Library service area. (Some restrictions may apply.)
- The 7-county area served by the Lake Agassiz Regional Library (LARL). (Some restrictions may apply.)

Your library card or an acceptable photo ID must be presented at checkout.

You are responsible for all items checked out on your card. If you lose your card, you can bring in your photo ID and get a replacement card for \$1.



My First Library Card is a special card design available to all children 7 years old and younger who have never had a Fargo Public Library card.

Computer Access Cards are issued to individuals who choose to use only internet/public computer services.

This card has no borrowing privileges. Computer Access cards provide up to four hours of computer access per day. Individuals sixteen years of age and older are eligible to register for a Computer Access card.

YOUR FPL RESPONSIBILITIES

In order to provide equitable access to collections, services, and resources, the Fargo Public Library does not charge late fines* for overdue items. Fees are charged for lost or damaged items per the library's policy.

Excessive outstanding fees can affect access to public computers.

*Note: Any item that is **more than 30 days overdue** is considered long overdue, and the cost of the item is automatically charged to the borrowing account. Upon return of the item(s) in good condition, lost item fees are automatically removed from the patron account.

Borrowers who have more than \$30 in outstanding fees on their account may not check out materials. Borrowing may resume when fees are reduced below the \$30 maximum by return of the item(s), or by payment of fees.

YOUR ACCOUNT

Access your account at www.fargolibrary.org. Click on "My Account" and enter your entire library card number (no spaces). Until you change it, your password defaults to your last name in ALL UPPER CASE letters.

RENEWALS

Eligible items will renew automatically up to two times (unless there is a waiting list). If you have questions about renewing your items, call (701) 241-1472.
