NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

This Addendum is prepared to supplement information presented in the Drawings and Project Manual dated April 28, 2023 and during the pre-proposal walk through for the above referenced project. All additions, changes, omissions and conditions listed herein shall become an integral part of the Contract Documents.

PROCUREMENT AND CONTRACTING REQUIREMENTS

O Add to Division 01 - General Requirements, 01 2100 - Allowances

SECTION 00 0116-1 PROJECT OVERVIEW

Replace Window Sunshade controls location text 6.ii. Controls located on north wall of door between Open Office 131 and Children's Area 110. See attached revised drawings A201 and E200 for updated location.

SECTION 00 0116-2 OWNER OCCUPANCY

Replace text for item D. Owner will coordinate with contractor's schedule and remove furniture and fixtures, including bookstacks, as required, adjacent to windows.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. SECTION 01 2100 - ALLOWANCES

Add Specification Section

2. SECTION 12 2400 - WINDOW SHADES

- o Paragraph 1.07.B.1: Change Shade Hardware warranty to "25 year"
- Paragraph 1.07.B.2: Change Fabric warranty to "25 year"
- o Paragraph 1.07.B.3: Change Aluminum and Steel Coatings warranty to "25 years"
- Paragraph 2.02.B.2.b.: Omit paragraph and subparagraphs for Double Roller Brackets.

DRAWINGS

1. A201 - FIRST FLOOR PLAN

- Drawing A6/A201: Change the location of the shades operating controls for Children's Area from Data 167 to the north wall of the door between Open Office 131 and Children's Area 110.
- Add "Plan Notes: Fasteners as needed for existing conditions. Extent of blocking unknown."

2. A202 - SECOND FLOOR PLAN

o Add "Plan Notes: Fasteners as needed for existing conditions. Extent of blocking unknown."

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3. E200 - FIRST FLOOR ELECTRICAL PLAN

o The control station for children's area 101 is to be relocated to room 131. Refer to Electrical Addendum #01 items.

4. REFERENCE REFLECTED CEILING PLANS

 Drawing sheets A152 and A153 are for reference only. JLG Architects cannot verify accuracy or completeness of information.

QUESTIONS and DISCUSSION DURING THE WALK THROUGH

- 1. Question: What is the schedule for this project? When would it begin?
 - Contractor Selection Approved by Commission June 2023 and Certification of Contract July 2023 as included in Specification Section 00 0116 PROJECT OVERVIEW.
- 2. Question: Do you have the lengths of the windows?
 - O Head heights of windows are shown on drawing sheets A201 and A202.
- 3. Question: What is the difference between Shade-1 and Shade-2?
 - Shade Fabrics (Shade-1) and (Shade-2) are addressed in Specification Section 12 2400, 2.03 SHADE FABRIC.
- 4. Question: Which shades are to be dual roller with two fabrics?
 - o There are no dual roller shades at any of the windows. That paragraph is now deleted.
- 5. Question: The electrical specifications call for 120 volt being converted to 24 volt DC, whereas, the drawings show that the existing wire will remain for 120 volt. What does the owner want?
 - O The wiring is 120 volt to the shades, but the motors are 24 volt. There is a power supply at each shade that converts to 24 volt to operate the motor.
- 6. Question: Would it be possible to get a reflected ceiling plan of the first and second floors?
 - o Reference RCPs are included in Addendum 01.
- 7. Question: Will we be able to get a plan detail or schedule showing exactly where reinforcement/blocking for the new shade system is needed? Or should we assume it will be needed at each shade location?
 - o No plan details or sections exist for the existing soffit above the windows. Contractor to provide a fastening system approved by the manufacturer. Where support for the fastening system is not compliant with the manufacturer's requirements, an allowance of \$10,000 shall be included in the contractor's proposal amount. An allowance section has been added via this addendum.
- 8. Question: Can we get a clarified definition of "especially noisy work"? Would that include any use of power tools, i.e. power drills, sheetrock saws, etc?
 - O Power tools use with noise levels 80 85 decibels shall be allowed during library hours. Tools that generate noise levels above 85 decibels shall be used during hours the library is not open to patrons.

Pre-proposal Walk Through Comments (not addressed elsewhere in Addendum 01)

- 9. Shade Fabric in Computer Lab 205 shall be (Shade-1) with a 1% openness factor in lieu of blackout shades that are being removed; Refer to drawing sheet A202.
- 10. No metal guides shall be installed at the blackout shades; refer to 12 2400, 2.02.6 Accessories for included items.
- 11. The only shade location that shall be removed and not replaced is the west shade at the north end of Meeting Room 152. Patch and refinish all work related to demolition of existing shades and as indicated on drawings whether new shades are installed or not. Refer to drawing sheet A201.

1.03 TIME AND MATERIAL ALLOWANCE

- A. Contractor's costs for products, delivery, installation, labor, insurance, payroll, taxes, equipment rental, overhead and profit shall be provided to the Architect for work of using the allowance.
- B. At closeout of Contract, allowance funds remaining will be credited to Owner by Change Order.

1.04 ALLOWANCES


A. Contractor shall fasten sunshades securely with a method approved by the manufacturer. Where existing conditions will not support a secure, manufacturer approved method of installation, the Contractor shall modify the substrate to allow for a secure installation. An allowance of \$10,000 shall be included in the proposal for providing adequate support for a secure, manufacturer approved installation. Contractor shall patch and paint disturbed areas to match existing. Contractor shall dilligently track time and materials related to this work to justify use of the allowance. At the end of the project, unused allowance funds shall be returned to the Owner by change order.





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
