





## WHAT IS BID?

- With property owner approval, allows City to defray the expense of improvements by special assessments and implement a specific scope of work that go above and beyond regular city services.
- ***NDCC Chapter 40-22.1:***  
Promotion of business activity and new business development through... including advertising, public information, marketing, maintenance and decoration of public places, promotion of public events, furnishing of music in any public place, providing professional management, planning, and promotion, and the general promotion of trade activities.



# HISTORY OF BID IN FARIBOROUGH


- 2011 - Amended NDCC to include cities above 10K pop.
- 2012 -
  - Engaged property owners.
  - Determined scope and support. Created boundaries and presented to City Commission.
  - Approved by City Commission and RFP to Administer Contract with DCP for Administration of BID
- 2017 – DCP BID agreement renewed for 3 years.
- 2021 – 1-Year Renewal
- 2022 – 1-Year Extension
- 2023 – 5-Year DCP BID Agreement



# ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY

## **ZONE 1 – Median \$900**

- Assess Value  $\$0.925 \times \$1,000$  of Total Assessed Value +  
0.0386 per Assessable Square Foot

## **ZONE 2 – Median \$300**

- Assess Value  $\$0.2315 \times \$1,000$  of Total Assessed Value +  
0.00965 per Assessable Square Foot

## **ZONE 3 – Median ~\$170**

- Assess Value  $\$0.0926 \times \$1,000$  of Total Assessed Value +  
0.00386 per Assessable Square Foot

## **ZONE 4 – Median ~\$170**

- Assess Value  $\$0.0926 \times \$1,000$  of Total Assessed Value +  
0.00386 per Assessable Square Foot

# 2025 BID STATS:

- **572 pieces of graffiti removed**
  - (808 in 2024)
- **6284 disinfected pieces of infrastructure: benches, crosswalk buttons, trash can lids, etc.** – (6920 in 2024)
- **56 referrals to Mobile Outreach Unit** – (55 in 2024)
- **Snow removal labor hours 588; 2323 location visits (ROW)** – (515 labor hours and 2312 location visits in 2024)
- **10,332 lbs. of Recycling**
  - (14,976 lbs. in 2024)
- **98,220 lbs. of Trash**
  - (93,999 lbs. in 2024)
