PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- This project will include the following:
 - 64th Avenue South (33rd Street South to 38th Street South)
 three-lane urban concrete street
 - I-29 Bridge Overpass Structure (No Interstate Access)
 - Concrete pavement
 - Curb and gutter
 - The center lane will be a designated left turn lane




PROJECT DESCRIPTION (CONT.)

- This project will include the following upgrades:
 - Sanitary sewer system installation
 - Storm sewer system installation
 - Water distribution installation
 - Pedestrian tunnel under 64th Ave near 37th Ave S to allow for grade separated pedestrian crossing
 - Shared use paths on both sides of 64th Ave
 - Street lighting

PROJECT TIMING AND DURATION

Bid Date:

November 13, 2020

Start Date:

To be determined (likely spring of 2021)

Completion Dates:

- 2021 Construction Season
 - Underground Utilities and Grading / Earthwork complete by fall 2021
- 2022 Construction Season
 - Concrete Paving and Bridge Construction complete by October 2022



PROJECT DETAILS AND IMPACTS

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- Existing I-29 west frontage road will be closed to thru traffic for the duration of the project.
- 64th Avenue between 25th St and 33rd St will remain open during the duration of the project but will experience increased construction traffic
- I-29 will experience the following impacts:
 - Reduced speeds and shoulder closures in 2021 and 2022
 - Nighttime closures (estimated 9 PM to 5AM for 8 days) in 2022 for bridge construction
 - There will be a posted detour during the nighttime closures




PROJECT COST

- Estimated Cost of Construction: \$16,739,970
- Right-of-Way and Easements: \$3,168,097
- Utility Relocations: \$296,804
- Fees and Contingency: \$5,189,391
 - Engineering Fee (10%)
 - Admin Fee (4%)
 - Legal Fee (3%)
 - Interest Fee (4%)
 - Contingency (10%)
- Total Project Cost: \$25,394,261



PROJECT FUNDING

- **Total Project Cost** (including fees + contingency): \$25,394,261
- Funding breakdown:
 - Infrastructure Sales Tax Funds: \$3,814,386
 - Cass Rural Water Funds: \$393,956
 - Federal Funds: \$11,122,482
 - Special Assessments Funds: \$10,457,393
