

# 2021 Community Gardens

A community garden is a plot of land gardened by people. The land can be owned publicly or privately and can be gardened by either the owners of the land, the people that join the garden, or both. True community gardens are open to everyone and provide an area to grow fruits and vegetables. The garden is divided into plots which can be gardened by individuals or groups. Whether or not there is a cost associated with claiming a plot is up to the owner(s) of the land and/or the organization managing the garden.

A full plot is 60 x 30 and has a one-time fee of \$35. The fee for a half plot is \$15. There are approximately 30 plots total. This garden has residents who have been gardening there for years that always return to their same plot. If plots are available, additional gardeners are welcome and a meeting is held in the spring (April) to assign plots to newcomers. The garden is part of the Park District and governed by bylaws/rules. A water system is available. Certain chemicals are banned.

The cost is \$20 per growing season; cash, check and credit card accepted. This community garden does not provide water to individuals who purchase plots.


The Growing Together Gardens are open to all in our community. These are not individual plot garden but are communal garden where the volunteers work together at a specific time each week and equally share during the harvest. To receive a full share of produce from any one of these gardens, a minimum hour requirement has been set for a volunteer member. Garden involvement starts in May and runs through first frost.
