## CONTEST RULES:

- The design must be your own original creation. Copyrighted characters or art (such as SpongeBob SquarePants©) will not be considered.
- Any 2D art medium may be used (paint, crayon, markers, colored pencil, digital art, etc. – no 3D materials).
- Please do NOT put any identifying information (name or age) in the design.
- All children ages birth through 12 years old are eligible to enter.
- Children may submit up to three (3) designs.
- All entries must be submitted to the **Main Library - Children's Department** by closing on **Sunday, March 31, 2019**.
- Winners will be announced on April 15, 2019.
- Three winners will be selected by library staff – one for each age group: 0 – 5, 6 – 8, and 9 – 12.
- Winning entries will be printed on full-color bookmarks to be distributed at the libraries and at library events throughout the year.

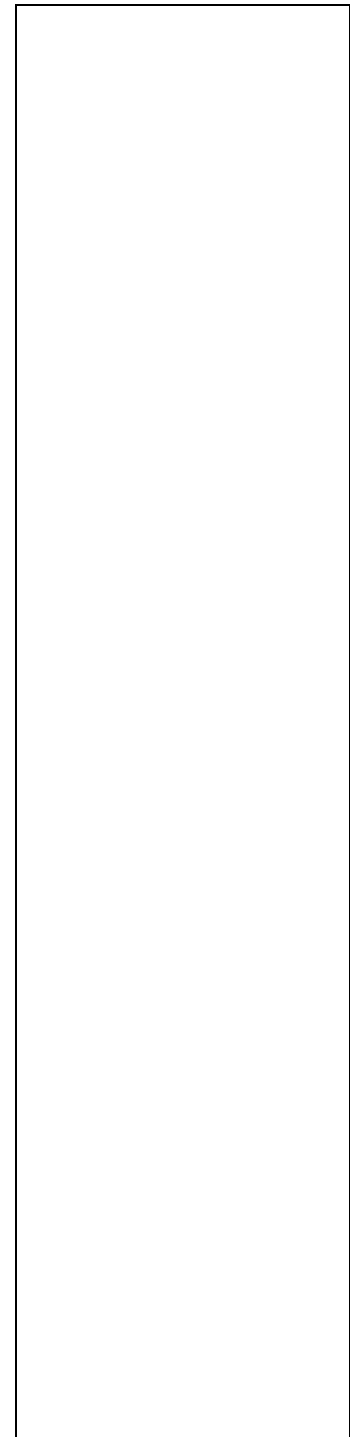
