

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING AS A CANDIDATE FOR CITY OF FARGO OFFICE

Election To Be Held June 14, 2016

1. Forms are available in the City Auditor's Office, 200 3rd Street North.
2. City Commission candidates **must** file a **Campaign Contribution Form**.
3. City Commission candidates must file a Statement of Candidacy and file a petition of nomination **OR** pay \$100.00 fee in lieu of filing petitions.
4. If petitions are filed, they must contain at least 300 signatures of qualified electors.
5. **All Candidates must file a Statement of Interest form.**
6. Filing deadline is no later than **4:00 o'clock Monday, April 11, 2016.**
7. Drawing for position on the ballot will be held at noon on **Tuesday, April 12, 2016**, in the City Commission Room.
8. Please be sure to indicate on your Statement of Candidacy how you would like your name printed on the Ballot.

ELECTION SEATS FOR 2016 CITY ELECTION

TWO CITY COMMISSIONERS - (4 year term) Must be a qualified elector in the City of Fargo and must have been in continuous residence for the last six months before filing nomination papers.

FILING REQUIREMENTS FOR STATEMENT OF INTERESTS

1. Every candidate for elective office shall file a Statement of Interests with the appropriate filing officer with whom the candidate filed his/her Certificate of Endorsement SFN 17196 or Petition/Certificate of Nomination SFN 2704.
 - a. Candidates for President and Vice President of the United States shall file with the Secretary of State either a Statement of Interests as required by Chapter 16.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code or a copy of the personal disclosure statement required by the Federal Election Commission.
 - b. Candidates for US Senate and US House of Representatives shall file this form with the Secretary of State or a copy of the personal disclosure statement required by the Federal Election Commission.
 - c. Candidates for statewide office shall file with the Secretary of State.
 - d. Candidates for legislative office shall file with the Secretary of State.
 - e. Candidates for Garrison Conservancy and Soil Conservation district shall file with the County Auditor in their county of residence.
 - f. Candidates for District Judge shall file with the Secretary of State.
 - g. Candidates for county offices shall file with the County Auditor.
 - h. Candidates for city offices shall file with the City Auditor.
 - i. Candidates for school district offices shall file with the School Business Manager of the school district.

The Statement of Interests shall be filed at the same time a Petition/Certificate of Nomination or Certificate of Endorsement is filed.

Candidates filing a Statement of Interests for the primary election need not re-file for the general election.

2. Every person appointed by the Governor to a state agency, board, bureau, commission, department, or occupation or professional licensing board shall file a Statement of Interests with the Secretary of State no later than the announcement of the appointment.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STATEMENT OF INTERESTS

WHO FILES: The Statement of Interests must be filed by all candidates seeking to have their name placed on the ballot for federal, statewide, judicial district, legislative, county, multi-district, city, and school district office. Every person appointed by the Governor to a state agency, board, bureau, commission, department, or occupation or professional licensing board shall also file a Statement of Interests.

WHEN TO FILE: Every candidate for elective office must file a Statement of Interests with the appropriate filing officer at the same time as filing his/her Certificate of Endorsement SFN 17196 or Petition/Certificate of Nomination SFN 2704 and Affidavit of Candidacy SFN 2703. Appointees of the Governor shall file a Statement of Interests no later than the announcement of the appointment.

HOW TO FILE:

ITEM A - PRINCIPAL OCCUPATION: The occupations listed are those defined on the North Dakota state income tax return. Check only one category for the principal source of income for yourself, and only one for your spouse. Please mark and complete the box labeled "Other" if you or your spouse's occupation is not listed.

ITEM B - List by name each **business or trust** that is **NOT** the principal source of income, in which you and/or your spouse have a financial interest. Include any of the following that apply:

1. Any business or trust in which you and/or your spouse own a legal or equitable interest.
2. Any business or trust in which you and/or your spouse have investments. Include the name of the business or trust of which you have stocks, mutual funds, bonds, debentures, or debt obligations of corporations and/or municipal corporations. Financial interests that are contained in diversified portfolios need only be mentioned by the brokerage establishment it is with.
3. Any business or trust from which you and/or your spouse receive compensation.
4. Any business or trust paying you and/or your spouse a fee or commission for professional or consulting services. Include those public agencies from which you and/or your spouse received a fee or commission. Attorneys and others who list their principal occupation as "professional" are not required to list clients.
5. Public agencies (state or local) to which you and/or your spouse sold goods or services.

ITEM D - Identify by name any **business office, business directorship, and fiduciary relationship** that you and/or your spouse have held in the preceding calendar year.

Fiduciary means acting as a guardian, trustee, executor, administrator, or conservator for any person, whether individual or corporate. Specify the capacity of the relationship of you and/or your spouse for any of the listed businesses, trusts and/or fiduciary relationships, such as "director", "executor", "trustee", etc.

SPECIAL NOTES:

Items B, C and D of this form have limited space for listing items. If you need more space, attach additional sheets in the same format and clearly identify which of the three items (B, C or D) the additional sheet continues. Insert the additional sheets into this form.

You are not required to list dollar amounts or the nature of the work performed in ITEMS B, C or D.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

A candidate for a county or city office (in cities with a resident population of 5,000 or more), is required by law to file a statement of contributions, known as a Campaign Contribution Statement (SFN 53970).

The statement must include the name and mailing address of all contributors who contributed in excess of \$200 in the aggregate during the reporting period, the aggregated amount of the contributions from each listed contributor, and the date the most recent contribution was received from that contributor.

A year-end report must be filed for any year in which a candidate's name appeared on the ballot or in which the candidate sought election through write-in votes. This report must be filed even if the candidate received no contributions during the year or any reportable contributions in excess of \$200.

For any year a candidate is not on the ballot, no year-end report must be filed unless the candidate received a contribution during the year. Then, a year-end report must be filed.

If applicable and if a report must be filed, please note the options in Schedule # 1, i.e., "No reportable contributions for reporting period" and "No reportable contributions since last report filed."

TYPES OF REPORTABLE CONTRIBUTIONS:

A gift, transfer, conveyance, provision, receipt, subscription, loan, advance, deposit of money, or anything of value, made for the purpose of influencing the nomination for election, or election, of any person to public office or aiding or opposing the circulation or passage of a statewide initiative or referendum petition or measure.

The term also means a contract, promise, or agreement, express or implied, whether or not legally enforceable, to make a contribution for any of the above purposes.

The term includes funds received by a candidate for public office or a political party or committee, which are transferred or signed over to that candidate, party, or committee from another candidate, party, or political committee or other source.

The term "anything of value" includes any good or service of more than a nominal value. The term "nominal value" means the cost, price, or worth of the good or service is trivial, token, or of no appreciable value. The term "contribution" does not include:

1. A loan of money from a bank or other lending institution made in the regular course of business.
2. Time spent by volunteer campaign or political party workers.
3. Money spent by a candidate on the candidate's own behalf.
4. Money or anything of value received for commercial transactions, including rents, advertising, or sponsorships made as a part of a fair market value bargained-for exchange.
5. Money or anything of value received by a candidate in that person's personal capacity, including pursuant to a contract or agreement made for personal or private employment purposes, and not received for a political purpose or to influence the performance of that person's official duty.
6. Contributions of products or services for which the actual cost or fair market value are reimbursed by a payment of money.
7. Independent Expenditure

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION STATEMENT

SECTION A: Campaign Contribution Statements must include information for contact purposes. The statement must indicate the name and daytime telephone number of the person completing the report, as well as the full name of the candidate, and the office the candidate is seeking or currently holding.

SECTION B: Campaign Contribution Statements must indicate that the report is a pre-primary, pre-general, pre-special, year-end, 48-hour, or amended report.

SECTION C: The person completing the report must certify that the information contained in the report is true, correct, and complete by signing and dating the Campaign Contribution Statement.

Aggregate contributions must reference the date of the most recent contribution. Contributions made separately by different persons from joint accounts are considered separate contributions for reporting purposes.

FILING INSTRUCTIONS: Campaign Contribution Statements are deemed properly filed when deposited with or delivered to the appropriate filing officer within the prescribed time. A statement that is mailed is deemed properly filed when it is postmarked and directed to the appropriate filing officer within the prescribed time. If a statement is not received by the filing officer, a duplicate of the statement must be promptly filed upon notice by the filing officer of its nonreceipt.
