The Permittee shall be required to notify the North Dakota One-Call Center at 1-800-795-0555 48 hours prior to excavation.

The Permittee shall be required to notify the Engineering Department of any road or lane closure 48 hours prior to closure.

PERMIT APPROVAL AND ACCEPTANCE OF WORK

In compliance with the above application and subject to all the terms, conditions and restrictions written or printed as general or special provisions on any part of this form and attached hereto, permission is granted to encroach or perform work within public rights-of-way.

All work in public right-of-way shall be per City standards, policies, codes, and these Special provisions as well as these general conditions, and shall be done to the satisfaction of the City Engineer or its representative.

All inspection costs incurred incidental to this work shall be borne by the Permittee unless otherwise specified on the face of the permit.

Utilities damaged or broken by Permittee shall be repaired or replaced to the satisfaction of their owners at Permittee's expense. Any trees, shrubbery, or landscaping damaged shall be replaced as directed by the City Engineer or its representative.

Any concrete to be removed shall be sawcut and replaced as directed to match existing in color, finish, and scoring. Asphalt to be removed shall be saw or spade cut. Permanent sidewalk, berm and pavement repairs shall be completed within 30 days of installation of facilities covered under permit. All traffic interference, control, detours, and lane closures shall be made in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and shall have Engineer's prior review and approval. The Permittee shall follow all guidelines in the traffic control operations program as it pertains to the "Traffic Control Supervisor" or "Watch Person." Costs of these warning devices shall be borne by the Permittee.

Non-compliance with these or other permit conditions may be cause for permit revocation.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

(Items checked shall be made part of permit)

- All trenches and/or open holes shall be filled, covered, or plated and adequately barricaded at the end of each day and whenever work is not in progress.
- Compaction tests required at locations and depths as determined by City Engineer at cost of Permittee.
- 90% minimum compaction required in berm areas. Mechanical compaction or flushing are acceptable.
- _____ 95% minimum compaction required in traffic areas.
- _____ Class 5 Gravel Backfill required.
- _____ Jack/bore facilities are as shown on plans.
