CLINIC SERVICES

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Family Planning Mission: Our primary mission is to protect your health and prevent an unintended pregnancy or sexually transmitted infection. Do not let the lack of money stop you from making an appointment to see a clinician or pick up your birth control supplies.

Program Philosophy: Planned families mean healthy babies are born to parents who are financially and emotionally prepared to care for them. The result is healthier, happier families. It is the belief of the North Dakota Family Planning Program that comprehensive, voluntary family planning services aimed at prevention are a necessity.

Fargo Cass Public Health will be closed on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Presidents Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, November 11 Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the clinic will be closed either the Friday before or the following Monday.

Inclement Weather Closing: If weather is in question, please call the clinic before coming to your appointment. Storm closures will be announced on Facebook, Twitter, local radio, and television stations.

Fees: Charges are based on income and size of family. Our sliding fee scale ranges from Code zero through Code four. Those clients who are a Code zero are not billed for services. Codes one through four are based on a percentage of the full fee. For example, Code one is charged 25% of full fee, Code two is 50%, Code three is 75%, and Code four is 100%. If your income falls into a paying category, you will be asked to pay for services and supplies at each visit. If you are unable to make payment at that time, and/or do not want to be billed to your home address, please make arrangements at the time of your visit. All family planning visits will be confidential and information to other sources **will not** be furnished without the written consent by the client, unless required by law, for medical treatment, or to obtain payment.

Donations: Donations for services are encouraged, accepted, and appreciated. Donations allow our program to continue.
