## Library Cards

A free Fargo Public Library card is available to all Fargo residents and Fargo property taxpayers with proof of identification and address. Library cards are valid for three years and must be presented at checkout.

Your card allows you to borrow up to 50 items from the library at a time and to use the public computers. Some formats have limits on how many items can be checked out on a card.

**You are responsible for all items checked out on your card.** Treat your library card like a credit card. Should your card be lost or stolen, call the library immediately. Card replacement costs \$1 per card.



Residents of West Fargo and the seven Minnesota counties served by the Lake Agassiz Regional Library System may obtain a free Fargo Public Library card when they present a library card from their home library.

Non-resident cards are \$20 for out-of-state residents and are free for residents of North Dakota. Paid non-resident cards are valid for one year. A card for computer use only is also available for a reduced fee.

**My First Library Card** is a special card available to children 7 years old and younger who have never had a Fargo Public Library card.



## Loan Periods

- Audiobooks and Read-Alongs (limit 20) ..... 3 weeks
- Books..... 3 weeks
- Book Club in a Bag (limit 1)..... 6 weeks
- DVDs (limit 20)..... 1 week
- Interlibrary Loan Items ..... 4 weeks (limit 4)

- Magazines..... 3 weeks
- Metro Arts Pass (limit 1)..... 3 weeks
- Music CDs (limit 20)..... 3 weeks
- Topic Totes (limit 1) ..... 3 weeks
- Video games (limit 2) ..... 3 weeks

Most library items can be renewed up to two times if there is not a waiting list. Book Club in a Bag Kits, Interlibrary Loan Items, and Metro Arts Passes do not renew.

## Renewals

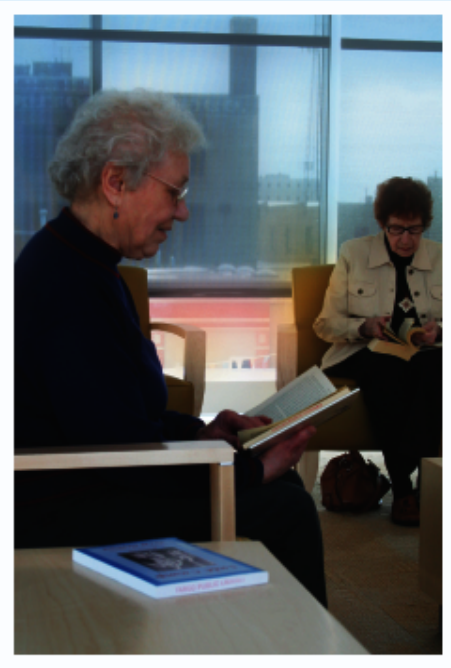
Almost all materials that can be checked out can be renewed up to two times if there is not a waiting list. Renewals may be requested in person, by telephone or online. Click on "My Account," and on the next page enter your entire library card number with no spaces. Until you change it, your password defaults to your last name in ALL UPPER CASE letters.
