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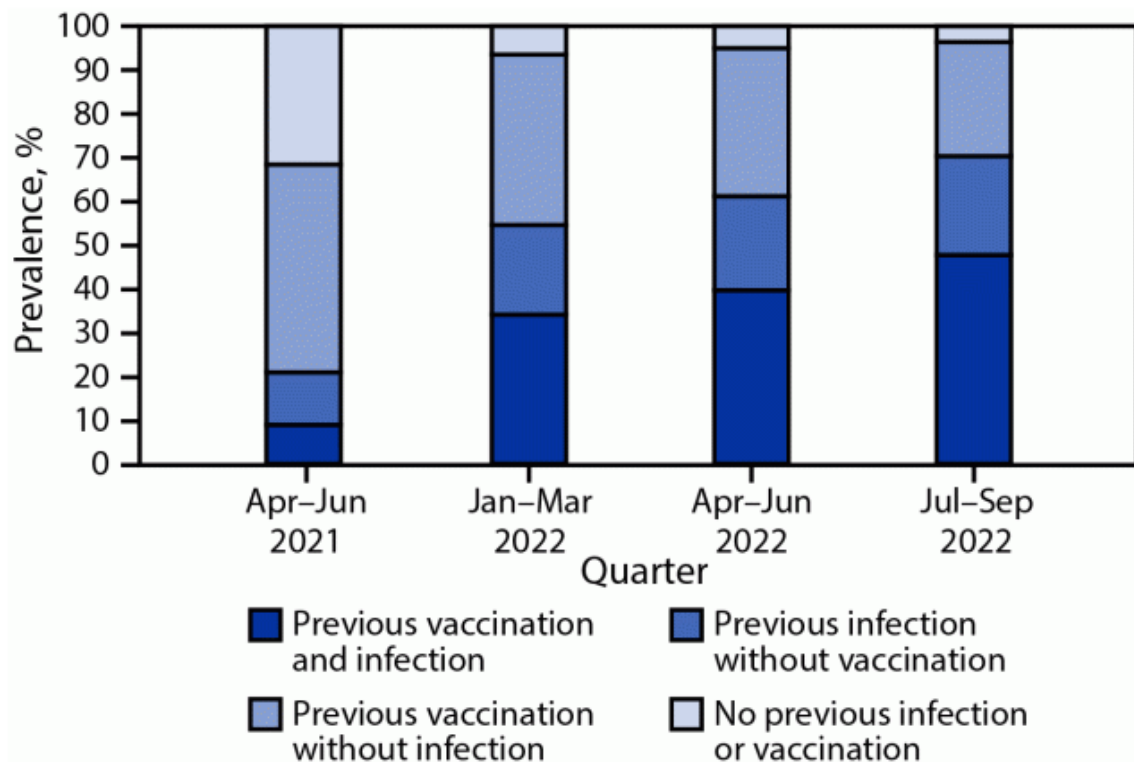

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CDC MMWR: NEARLY ALL AMERICANS HAVE SARS-COV-2 ANTIBODIES

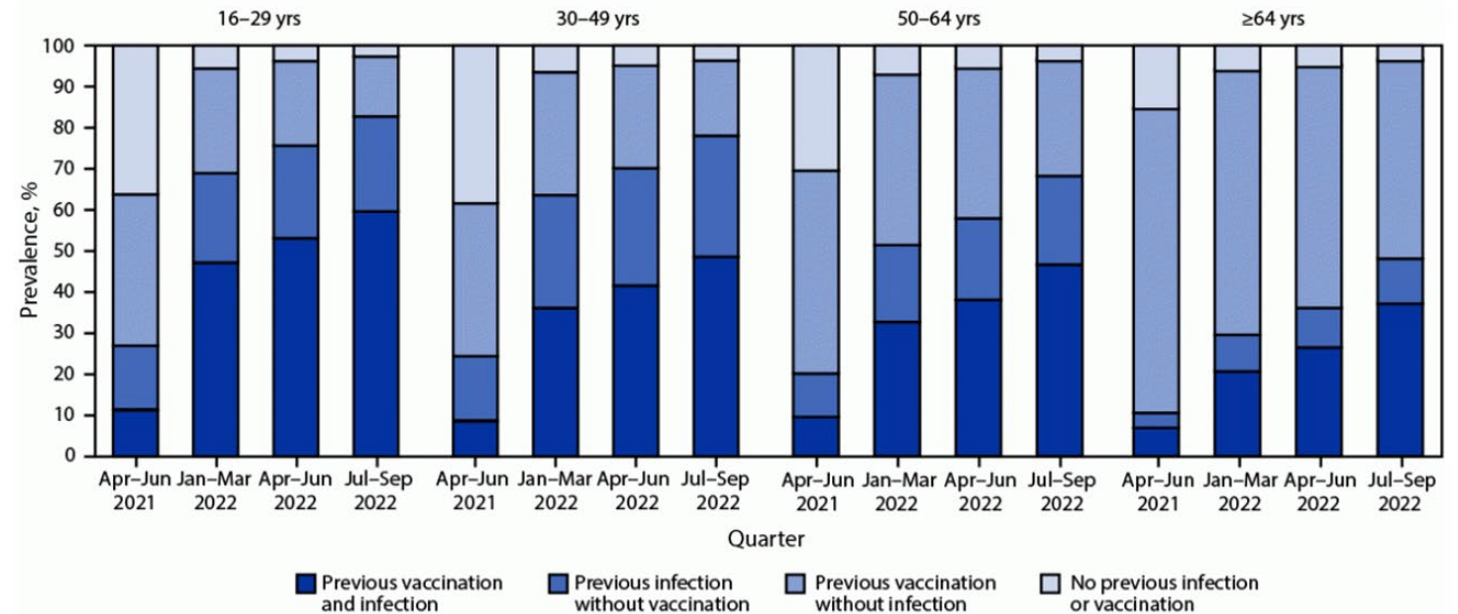


- New data suggests 96% of Americans ≥ 16 years have antibodies against SARS-CoV-2 from infection, vaccination, or both
 - ~23% infection alone
 - 26% vaccination alone
 - Nearly 48% hybrid immunity

CDC MMWR: LOWER INFECTION-INDUCED & HYBRID IMMUNITY IN ≥ 65

- Public health implications: successful infection prevention efforts led to low prevalence of non-vaccine immunity in older adults (highest risk for severe disease); important for this group to stay UTD on COVID-19 vaccination, including 1 bivalent dose

FDA APPROVES RSV VACCINES FOR ADULTS ≥60

- RSV = common illness resulting in thousands of hospitalizations and deaths in this age group each year
- GSK vaccine Arexvy approved
- Pfizer vaccine ABRYSSVO™ now approved for older adults
 - Also being evaluated for use during pregnancy to protect infants
- CDC's ACIP will consider best uses for vaccines and make recs by end of June 2023



Among people aged 60 years and older, Pfizer's RSV vaccine was:

U.S. Conference of Mayors released survey data from 117 cities in 39 states

FALL COVID VACCINES WILL TARGET XBB VARIANTS

- Monovalent Omicron XBB.1.5 vaccine
- CDC will decide who gets updated vaccines (everyone vs high-risk groups)
- FDA to follow data and decide how frequently vaccines need to be updated (more than once a year not expected)
- No combined flu-COVID vaccine yet
