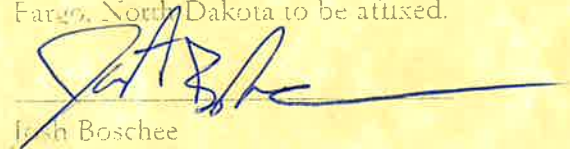
WHEREAS, The citizens of Fargo demonstrate a steadfast commitment to maintaining the integrity of our historic districts for the education and enjoyment of future generations.
