WHEREAS, thousands of residents experience food insecurity each year, relying on local food pantries, community meal programs and neighborhood-based initiatives to help meet daily needs; and

WHEREAS, these challenges fall hardest on people with low incomes, people with disabilities, youth, older adults and those navigating long-standing systemic barriers; and

WHEREAS, addressing hunger and homelessness requires a united effort that strengthens prevention, expands access to food and housing, and ensures every resident can reliably meet their most basic needs; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the dedication of food access organizations, housing providers, health systems and volunteers who work every day to support residents and create pathways toward stability; and

WHEREAS, Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week calls on everyone to deepen their understanding of these issues; and

WHEREAS, the City affirms that ensuring reliable access to food, housing and supportive resources is essential to the community's health, vitality and future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Dr. Timothy J. Mahoney,
