  - a.    Application for a class “ABH” alcoholic beverage license for Aparium Hotel Group d/b/a Jasper Hotel to be located at 215 Broadway North.
  - b.    Application for a transfer of a class “FA-Golf” alcoholic beverage license from Big Erv’s Bar & Grill LLC d/b/a Big Erv’s at Rose Creek to Living the Dream, LLC d/b/a Legends to be located at 1500 E Rose Creek Parkway South.
