With respect to said negotiations and a potential agreement between the City and the Fargo Municipal Airport Authority, or a decision by the Airport Authority to seek out and retain vendors outside the City of Fargo, these have financial implications and an open meeting discussion of the negotiations, strategy and direction to the Chairman and/or MAA's attorney, would create an adverse fiscal effect on the bargaining position of the MAA.
