Entries are accepted March 1 – April 30, 2022

All entries must be accompanied by an entry form. Incomplete entries will not be considered. Make sure to include all of the information required on the entry form. You may submit up to one (1) entry per category. You may submit to more than one (1) category: short stories, poetry, comics, nonfiction essays, drawing, or photography.

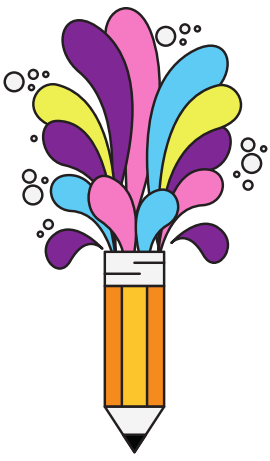

Guidelines for Entries

For authors:

- Writing entries (short stories, essays, poems) need to be typed or written in black ink on 8.5 x 11 inch white paper. Pages need to be single sided – do not write or draw on both sides of the paper.
- Short stories can be accompanied by illustrations (not in a comic book style); illustrations must be on the same page as text and entry is limited to four (4) pages.
- Short stories (with no illustrations) and essays are limited to two (2) pages single spaced or four (4) pages double spaced.
- Poems are limited to one (1) page (single or double spaced).
- Comics are limited to four (4) pages including both drawings and text. Comics must be outlined in black ink but color may be used to fill them in.
- Acceptable media for comics and illustrations are colored pencils, markers, crayons, or digital color. No collage or paint will be accepted.
- Do not use copyrighted characters in illustrations.

For artists:

- Drawings must be on white 8.5 x 11 inch paper. Drawings may include color.
- Acceptable media for drawings are colored pencils, markers, crayons, or digital color. No collage or paint will be accepted.
- Drawings may be vertical or horizontal, but vertical will display best.
- Do not use notebook or lined paper.
- Digital entries must be scanned. Photos of drawings will not be accepted.
- Do not use copyrighted characters in drawings.

For photographers:

- Photographs must be high resolution images (at least 300 dpi is recommended).
- Photographs may be vertical or horizontal, but vertical will display best.

Submissions may be made three ways:

- By mail – each entry must include an entry form

Each entry should be a separate email and include an entry form. Email entries can be Word documents or PDFs. For photographs, email entries should be JPEG format.

- In Person – drop off entries at any Fargo Public Library location. Each entry must include an entry form. Please do not staple your entry – paperclips or envelopes work best.
