WHEREAS, Social Security currently supports more than 146,541 residents in North Dakota by helping to meet basic needs such as housing, food and healthcare, and generates nearly \$3 billion annually in economic activity for the North Dakota economy; and

WHEREAS, Social Security is earned by workers through a lifetime of contributions and has stood the test of time, offering peace of mind to people from all backgrounds; and


