WHEREAS, There are an estimated 37 million adults in the U.S. with kidney disease and 1 in 3 adults in the U.S. are at risk; and

WHEREAS, Most people are unaware that the risk factors for kidney disease include diabetes, heart disease, high blood pressure, obesity and family history, with diabetes being a leading cause for kidney disease; and

WHEREAS, People who are Black or Hispanic are at increased risk for developing kidney disease; and

WHEREAS, It is critical that attention be brought to this often overlooked but increasingly common disease; and

WHEREAS, The month of March is National Kidney Month and March 14, 2024 is World Kidney Day; and

WHEREAS, The National Kidney Foundation is calling on everyone to participate in raising awareness of kidney disease.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That I, Dr. Timothy J. Mahoney,
