READING LOG & READER'S CHALLENGE DIRECTIONS

- To register for the Summer Reading Program:
 - Participation is FREE.
 - The Fargo Public Library Summer Reading Program officially starts **Monday, June 4, 2018**. Stop by any Fargo Public Library location on or after this date to register and pick up a Reading Log. Registration forms and schedules are available at each location and on our website. Call **701.241.1495** or visit our website www.fargohlibrary.org/kids for more details.
 - To earn prizes, you must read (or be read to) for **10 hours**. You will receive a prize for every 10 hours you read up to 40 hours. Record the time you read using the inside of the Reading Log. In addition to silent or individual reading, listening to audiobooks, reading out loud to others, and attending storytimes also count towards your total time. Both print books and ebooks (read on a device like a tablet or Kindle) qualify.
 - To earn a book, you must read for a total of **40 hours**.
- To complete the Reading Challenge:
 - Answer the questions in the space provided and complete the activities. To finish the Reader's Challenge, complete **all questions and activities** and collect 5 stickers for attending library events, donating food or toiletry items, completing the Fargo History Hunt, or completing activity sheets.
 - When you attend a library event, donate food or toiletry items, complete the Fargo History Hunt, or complete an activity sheet, library staff will give you a sticker for the large circles. Activity sheets are available at each Fargo Public Library location.
- To have your picture and/or name in The Forum:
 - Any child who reads, or is read to, for a total of **40 hours** and completes the Reader's Challenge will get their picture and/or name published in **The Forum on Saturday, August 25, 2018** (as space allows).
 - Turn in your completed Reading Log to library staff, along with a photo of yourself (printed on photo paper and no smaller than 2x3") with your name on the back, no later than **August 4, 2018 at 6pm**. Portrait shots like school photos are preferred. (Photos not returnable.)
- To be entered into the end-of-summer prize drawing:
 - When you are eligible for a prize, you will receive a **coupon** to fill out to enter the end-of-summer prize drawing. Every 10 hours of reading earns you prize-drawing coupon.
 - Once you have received the 40 hour prize, you can continue to read (at 10 hour intervals) to earn additional prize-drawing coupons.





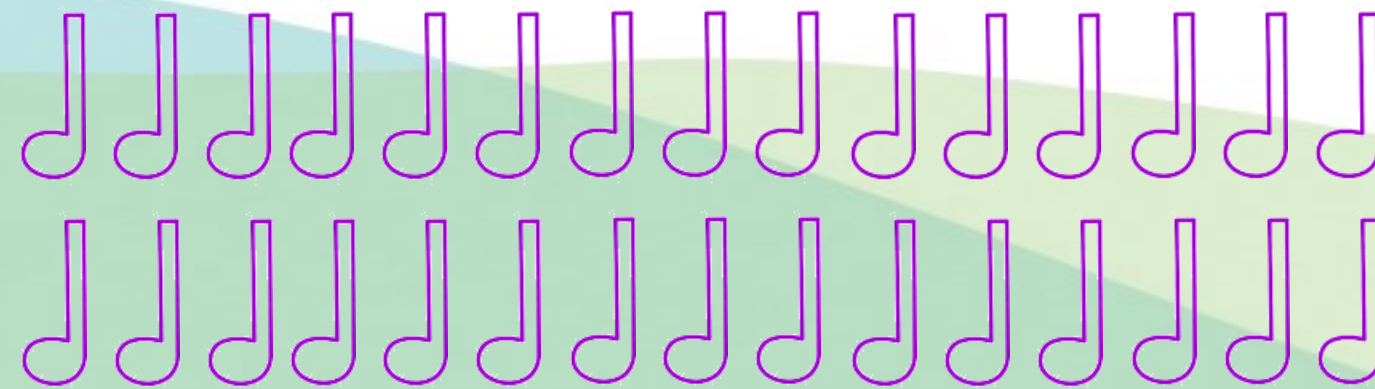
