Preparing for Legislative Session 2023

The 2023 Legislative Session is right around the corner. Tobacco Free North Dakota (TFND) has identified the following priorities for 2023. **Join us at our virtual coalition meeting on December 14th at 11am to learn more about how to assist TFND with these priorities! Email Annabel to RSVP.**

1. Protect ND's Smoke-Free Law
2. Advocate for funding to be restored to the Tobacco Prevention and Control budget to CDC-recommended levels
3. Propose policy language for electronic nicotine delivery systems (ENDS) products classification as tobacco products
4. Educate all new and existing policymakers on the components of the 3-legged stool of CDC best practice policy recommendations for tobacco prevention
5. Support partners and allies in their advocacy efforts whenever they align with TFND's mission and legislative priorities
